### Cannon Finds New Home



With the help of many community members a salvaged cannon from the wreaked San Jose Spanish Ship has found yet another new home.

Zully Hemeyer and Ralph Salvatory from the Public Works Department in the Village of Islamorada worked with Mark Page from Page Excavating and Mike from Guy's towing to move the cannon to its new home at the First State Bank's Key Largo Tradewinds office. The Village had housed the cannon since it was moved for the third time. The hope is that this will be its last home until it is placed in a Historical museum planned by the Matecumbe Historical Trust.

The cannon came from the San Jose, one of the Spanish ships wrecked along the Keys, in July of 1733 and was donated several years ago by Ronald Molinari, DDS, from Tavernier who worked this wreck. The cannon, more than 9-feet long and weighing 3000 pounds was taken to Tallahassee and spent three years in electrolysis. It was taken






