· Drink water, and lots of it, preferably not distilled or tap water. A better choice is reverse osmosis or waters such as Fiji and Penta. Water must be maintained in the body to keep it hydrated as well to prevent a concentration of acid build up. Avoid soda or sports drinks. To quote one urologist, "If people would not drink

- soda or sports drinks I would be out of business."
- · Take aloe: this combines with the calcium in the urinary tract and significantly reduces the growth rate of urinary calcium crystals
- · Avoid aluminum and alkalis (antacids)
- Eat more fruits and vegetables, and switch from white bread to

- whole wheat (organic is always your best bet)
- · Control your weight and lessen your stress level. These two issues are important for carbohydrate metabolism, since weight and insulin insensitivity lead to a condition known as hypercalciuria and thus place you at high risk for kidney stones. · According to Adelle Davis,

the fundamental chemical cause of kidney stones is a deficiency in magnesium, B-6 and zinc.




