Well, "Son of a son of a bitch!" "Why don't we get drunk and screw the Conch Republic Coconut Telegraph?" "A publisher looks at jail?" NOT. Looks like those land sharks think we're rich.

This publication gets by each month from the businesses that advertise in it. Our rates are low because we have no big fancy building and huge staff. We do it all in our homes on our computers. Saves the advertisers a bunch. By no means are we getting rich though we are however helping our community by

running free ads for benefits and local charities. Is that what the land sharks want to take away? Jimmy Buffett is a billionaire yet what has he done for the Conch Republic? "Island Music at its Best"




