...Continued from page 19 indicator above, the low potassium level. These individuals, like the fast oxidizers, need to slow down tremendously. They are "burning themselves out" and will not get well if they do not change their lifestyle and often their thinking patterns to reflect a more peaceful and more gentle approach to their lives. They need to help their bodies get out of the fight-orflight mentality. Unlike the fast oxidizers, these individuals are quite burned out. They often need to slow down mentally as much as they need to slow down physically. They may need to engage in more spiritual or other pursuits that inspire, relax and reassure themselves, and one need not be in fight-or-flight as much of the time. As with fast oxidation, this is a very

important lifestyle change that is needed, or these patients will make very slow progress on any program. The simple reason is that the sympathetic nervous system inhibits their digestive. eliminative and immune systems. This really inhibits any healing program that they may undertake.

Sympathetic dominance in children is unfortunately quite common, especially in teenagers. These young adults are over stimulated with music. or soft drinks or even tea or coffee. They may also have much on their minds, between school pressures, home pressures, boyfriends and girlfriends, and so forth.

Teens and most adults, for that matter, need less stimulation, more (often much more) rest and sleep, and often a more relaxed home and school life.


