Rescued Dolphin Marine Mammal Conservancy



Cutter is a baby dolphin that was rescued in Key West. He is currently at the Marine Mammal Conservancy (MMC) at mile marker 102 in Key Largo.

The rescued calf is approximately 5'6" long and weighs about 85-pounds. He is estimated to be between 1 to 3 years of age. Cutter will remain in the care of the Marine Mammal Conservancy until he is deemed healthy enough to be released by the staff, veterinarians, NMFS and consultants of NMFS.

The Marine Mammal Conservancy is an all volunteer IRS 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization that focuses on the research, rescue, rehabilitation and release of wild stranded animals.
