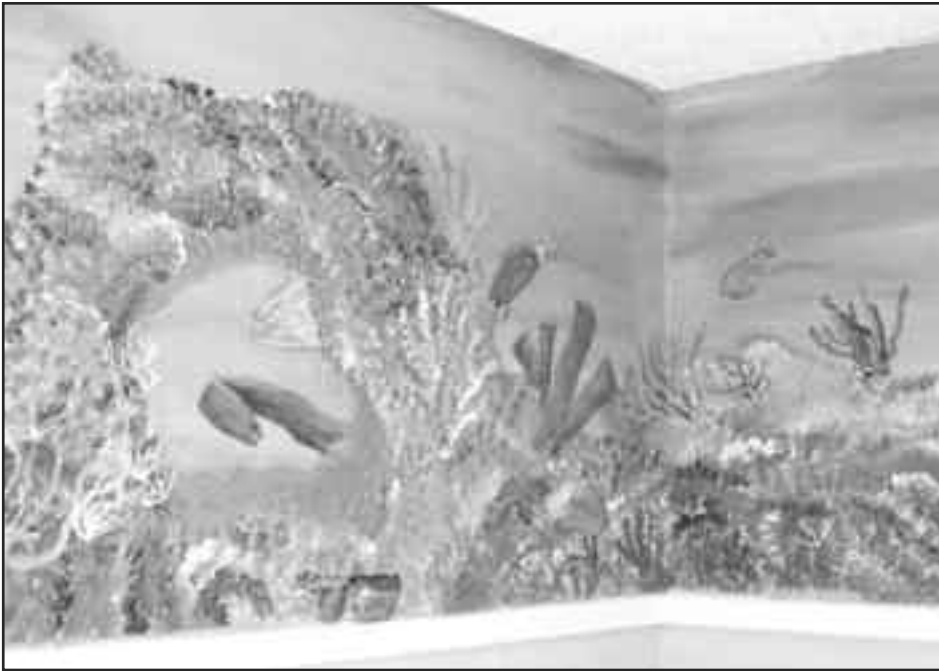


Brooke Spaulding

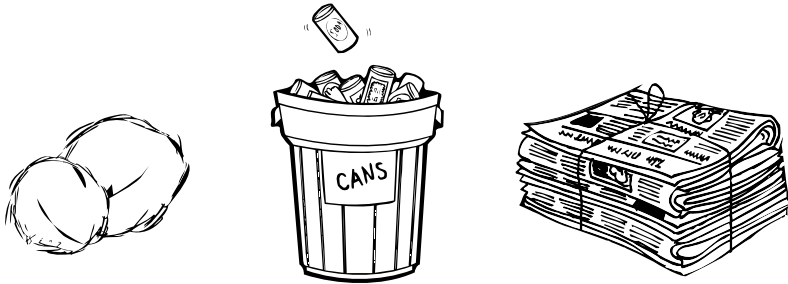
