




Terri Bice. owner of Mom's Taxi's says the company's 20-year anniversary is "bittersweet". Bice and her husband Gary, who recently passed, bought the business eight years ago.

"Gary, known to the locals as Hippie, was a driver for the company and when the previous owners put it up for sale we bought it," says Bice. "Gary passed away in March of this year from live cancer and he ran the business right up to the day he died." From that day forward Terri has taken over the business. She quickly learned how to program the drivers and pay the bills, "That alone is a full time job", she says.

Mom's Taxi (Key Largo Cabs, LLC) has been serving the upper Keys from Ocean Reef to Islamorada for 20 years and in honor of Gary Bice. his widow Terri wants the public to know that she has lowered the rates.

"Back when gasoline went sky high we had to raise them. We hated to do it but we had to in order to survive," she says.

It costs a lot to run a cab company. Bice showed the Coconut Telegraph her insurance bill for liability (she carries more than the required amount) and it costs her \$1,390.00 a month.

"Many other cab companies do not carry full liability insurance," she tells us. "People don't care about insurance when they have been drinking and need a ride until something happens to them. Then they care."
