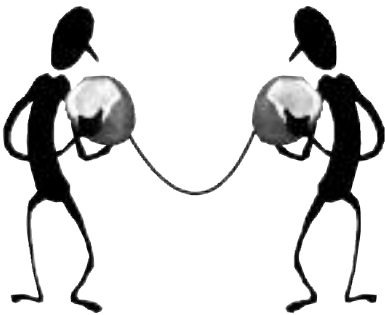

Annual Island Grill Charity Dolphin Tournament Nets \$5000 For Team TNT

Team **TNT** took home a Pasta Pantaleo print, and a check for \$5,000 in the recent Annual Island Grill Charity Dolphin Tournament, sponsored by Mercedes-Benz of Cutler Bay and Tavernier Creek Marina. The yearly tournament raises money for the Baptist Children's Hospital Cancer Center.

TNT's Captain Tedd Amberg with anglers Lee Manner and Tammi Amberg all from Naples would turn in two fish weighing 21.4 and 12.6 pounds. Combined with Tammi's 22.2 pound dolphin, which was the largest fish in the Ladies division, the team posted a 58.2 pound total.

Second place went to team **Tooth Ache** with Travis Bennett of Tavernier, Michael Hartley of Key Largo, and Captain Kenny Spaulding from Islamorada fishing. Michael Hartley weighed the largest fish by a male angler, 30.8 pound dolphin. The **Tooth Ache's** combined weight of three fish totaled 48.1 pounds. The team took home the second place trophy and a check for \$1,000.

Anglers Victor Perez from Key Largo, and Quincy Duval Saint of Davie, Florida fishing aboard the **Sweet & Law** weighed in a 16.6, 22.8 and 4.2 pound dolphin for a total of 43.6. The third place total netted the team \$500 and a beautiful Pasta Pantaleo print. Junior Angler Quincy Duval Saint won the Junior division with the 16.6 pound dolphin.

All the mahi-mahi weighed was filleted and served at the awards dinner. John and Kyle Ouellette,



members of the Dolphin Tagging Research Center, cleaned the fish. John was excited to find the remains of a 12" dolphin in the stomach of the 30.8 bull dolphin. He also found large pieces of the sole of a shoe or flip flop in the stomach of the 22.2 pound dolphin caught by Tammi Amberg. John is sending these items to the research center.

Other awards were given for Largest Tuna and Most Unusual Catch. Marc Firestone of Islamorada, fishing aboard the **Perfection**, weighed in the tuna at 7.2 pounds. The **Assault Cracker's** angler Jim Nance took home a \$100 Island Grill Gift certificate for the Most Unusual Catch a .5 pound puffer fish.

The Island Grill Charity Dolphin Tournament hosted 100 anglers on 37 boats during the annual event. With the help of many sponsors and donated items, Jack McCormick and the Island Grill are able to award a very nice check to the Baptist Children's Hospital Cancer Center. The tournament thanks all the sponsors, businesses, and people who donated time and money to make this year's event the best ever!

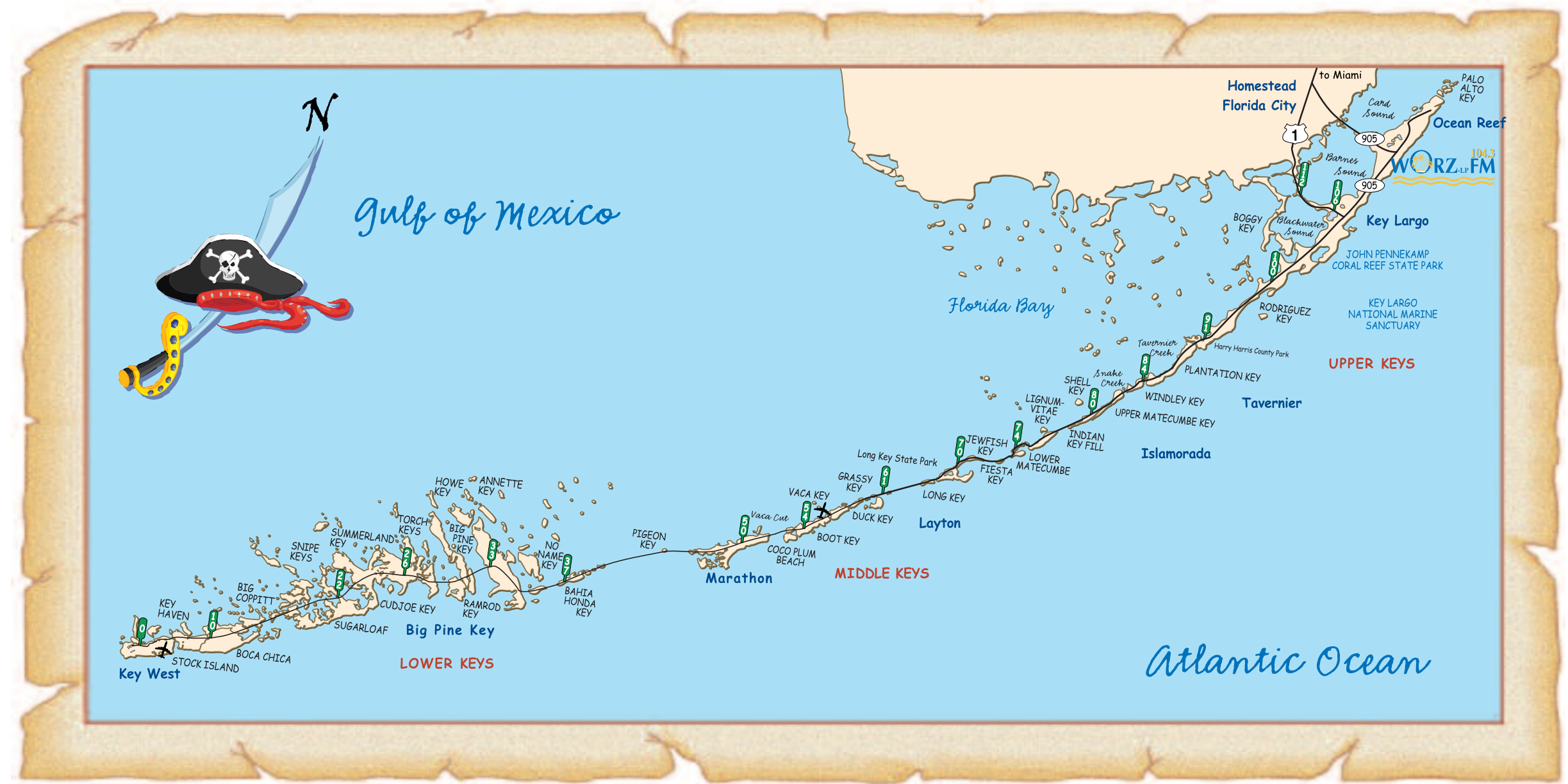

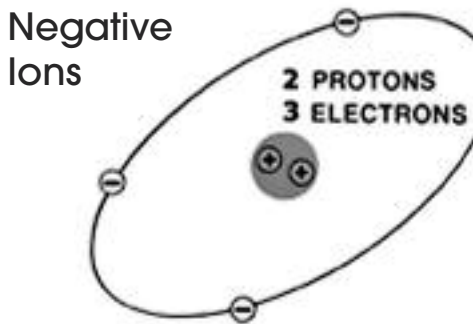

New App to Locate DUI Checkpoints

Does it Discourage Drinking and Driving or Facilitate Abusers?

Has anyone heard about this? At first I thought it was a joke. Apparently it's not.

There's a new iPhone app called DUI Dodger; it was released on April 7. Guess what one of its functions is? As the name implies, this little program will help drivers locate the nearest sobriety checkpoint — presumably so they can avoid it.

I don't know about you, but that sounds like the beginning of a very bad story to me.

To be fair, the application has other uses, such as estimating your blood-alcohol level (based on your size and the number of drinks consumed) and checking to see if you can walk the line — the age-old sobriety field-test. But the most controversial part of the application is definitely the "DUI Checkpoint Finder," which locates current police checkpoints within 50 miles of the user and pinpoints them on a map.

This is how the company press release describes the feature:

In some states, DUI checkpoints are more rampant than ever. Fight back with DUI Dodger, the app that allows you to view and submit DUI checkpoints in your area. The idea is that information is power, and people will be less inclined to drink and drive if they know that there is a checkpoint in their area, that they are drunk, and that driving drunk carries major consequences.

Doesn't that strike you as just a little disingenuous? Some people might be persuaded by that information to stay sober or stay home, but others might be inclined to drink, use the app to plan their trip home, or to the next bar,

avoiding the safety check points

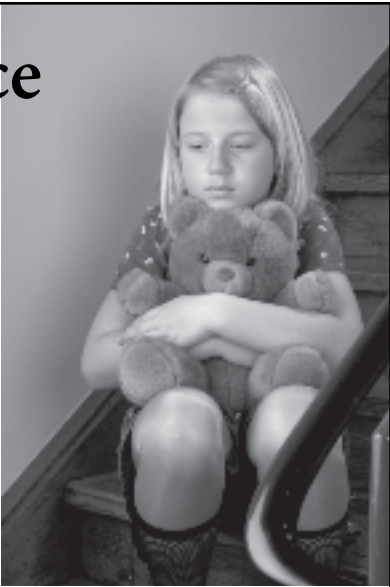
