Artist of the Month - MK Jackson



in the Keys about 3 years ago, during an annual month-long visit to Island Dolphin Care for her eldest daughter, who challenges cerebral palsy. MK is the published author of a children's book, "My Name is Guenavere, And I Talk Through My Eyes." The book deals with special needs and educating, it teaches that "different" is not scary.

MK is an acrylic artist, specializing in portrait work, favoring memorial art She donates portraits to Dallas Children's Hospital, Cook Children's Medical Center, and Artists For A Cause, to bring parents comfort during a loss.

MK works on a large scale with mosaics, adding art to common spaces where they are least expected, such as an octopus in dazzling glass wrapped around a pool, or a leaping stallion behind a spa tub.

MK began commissioning private work Pieces such as glass flamingos dancing in a kitchen behind a counter, or a king lion behind a man-cave bar make her work not only unusual, but an eye-enchanting surprise.
