I was in the neighborhood having dinner at a friend's house when she told me that her healthy 5-year-old cat had been missing for several days. We talked as she hung her laundry out to dry in her back yard and we noticed the neighbor had a trap that they use to trap feral cats. Could this be a coincidence, we wondered?

Not long afterward we heard of another family on the next street losing their cat. Neither of these cats were turned in to either humane society and neither of the cats returned to their loving homes. There is nothing legally that can be done unless this person is caught in the act. We strongly recommend that if you live in the neighborhood around 1st

and 2nd Court that you keep your cats inside. There is a sicko on the loose.

Experts say that people who are cruel to animals are more likely to engage in criminal activity, are dangerous to other people and prone to domestic violence. They are control freaks.

It is not a crime to trap animals but it is a crime to kill them and is punishable with up to a \$10,000 fine according to Florida statutes.
