



When multi-platinum sound engineer, mixer and producer Rod Hui is home in Key Largo you may see him visiting friends at the Pilot House or stopping by the Big Chill for a cold beer. You would never guess that he is famous, and one of the early pioneers of hip-hop and rap recording. So famous that he travels the world turning music into best-selling albums.

Since Hui began his career in 1977 he has mixed hits for Shannon, Run DMC, Kurtis Blow, LL Cool J, Public Enemy, George Bensen, Chaka Khan, Mary J Blige, Aretha Franklin, Pete Rock, and Whodini, as well as recordings for Bonnie Tyler, Air Supply, Salt-N-Pepa, Ah-Ha and John Cale. There are more, but we only have so much space!

Rod has a knack for being involved with an artist at the beginning of completely new genres. He has produced and mixed "Let The Music Play" for Shannon, "It's Like That" and

"Sucker MC" for Run DMC. Rod also mixed "Hot Cool and Vicious" for Salt-N-Pepa, as well as "It Takes a Nation of Millions" and "Fear of a Black Planet" for Public Enemy. These continue to be important underpinnings for the direction of pop music today.

Rod helped define a sound that is a strong foundation for much of today's popular music. While building on a significant foundation of technique, experience and major record label relations, Rod has embraced today's recording and mixing technology and continues to raise the bar for record production.

Rod is an instructor at the Clive Davis Department of Recorded Music at NYU and has been teaching courses there since 2005. "Having the opportunity to pass on my experience and knowledge to the next generation of recording engineers and producers is most rewarding."

Picture this: Outdoors, under the scorching sun on a construction site, looking around at the other workers during a break. It's hot. Sweat dripping off elbows, noses, chins, little streams trickling down your chest like drunken crabs running down a sand

The workers are thinking about the next segment of work. Finishing the smoke as the boss says, "Hit it."

Quitting time, finally. Stop by a local joint and grab a beer and light up. Tell a few jokes and head home.

"Hi Babe." Hug the kids and romp a bit with the pooch. Grill is smoking. Mama brings a cold beer and smokes. I earned this. Have been for many years. Tough guy needs some simple pleasure. Funny though, I worry about going to the mall and a baby sneezes on me. I might get sick and miss work. Things are tough enough as it is.

Let's see, 2 packs of smokes a day and 6 or 8 beers. Two at the joint and a \$1 tip, \$2 if it's Friday. Thats about \$90 a week. I earned it. Got to have some pleasure with all this hard work. I make \$18 an hour, take home \$650, that's \$2,600 a month. Pay all the bills with a little left over.

The little voice. "Hey sport, let's see. No insurance, no savings, no college fund, but things will get better."

\$90 a week for a year is about \$4,700. That's \$70,000 for 15 years. The cost for saving your life with throat cancer is about \$400,000. Take my word on it.



There is beauty and power when we listen to the whisper.




You may have noticed that if you want to speak to someone in a noisy, crowded room, the best thing to do is lean close and whisper. Yelling in an attempt to be louder than the room's noise generally only hurts your throat and adds to the chaos. have heard what it has to Similarly, that still, small voice within each of us does not try to compete with the mental chatter on the surface of our minds, nor does it attempt to overpower the volume of the raucous world outside. If we want to hear it, no matter what is going on around us or even inside us, we can always tune in to that soft voice underneath the surrounding noise.

We may find that our own communications in the world begin to be influenced by the quiet certainty of this voice. We may be less inclined to indulge in idle chatter as we become more interested in maintaining our connection to the whisper of truth that broadcasts its message like the sound of the wind shaking the leaves of a tree. As we align ourselves more with this quiet confidence, we become an extension of the whisper, penetrating the noise of the world and creating more peace, trust, and confidence.
