

Funny though, I worry about going to the mall and a baby sneezes on me. I might get sick and miss work. Things are tough enough as it is.

Let's see, 2 packs of smokes a day and 6 or 8 beers. Two at the joint and a \$1 tip, \$2 if it's Friday. Thats about \$90 a week. I earned it. Got to have some pleasure with all this hard work. I make \$18 an hour, take home \$650, that's \$2,600 a month. Pay all the bills with a little left over.


The little voice. "Hey sport, let's see. No insurance, no savings, no college fund, but things will get better."
