

The paper is always available on line for free at TheConchTelegraph.

Why are we growing while others fail?

Print newspapers advertising has been on a decline while online continues to grow. Across the nations many newspapers have folded, cut employees and expenses or gone strictly online.

There are many different formats for newspapers or publications. Here are a few.

Broad sheet - A newspaper with a large page format, regarded as more serious and less sensationalist than tabloids.

Berliner - Larger than and shorter than the broadsheet format. Many broadsheet newspapers have gone to this size to save money on printing costs.

Tabloid - Small newspaper with short articles: a smallformat popular newspaper with a simple style, many

photographs, and sometimes an emphasis on sensational

Shopper or Pennysaver -A free newspaper that only has advertising and little or no content. Unless they are chock full of classified or personal ads, these go from the mailbox directly into the garbage. They can claim to have a huge circulation but what good is it if no one reads it and 90% of them wind up in the trash?

I love our local weekly newspapers but I do not always have the time to find one and read them. Online I am able to quickly read their top news stories and skip the ads.

The Coconut Telegraph is

around the house for a full month so you don't miss a thing. We have a paid distribution spot at the Publix supermarket and we try hard to keep it full for your convenience. There is also a box at the Key Largo Winn Dixie and a box outside the Key Largo Chamber of Commerce at MM 106. We have to maintain about 100 distribution locations but will gladly add your business to our circulation list if you give us a call

And then there are magazines. Printed on slick paper and colorful, magazines - are not sources of fresh content. They take too long to produce to be current. There are a couple new ones a monthly tabloid that hangs being mailed to parts of the







Tree Removal Shady

Property located at 2 North Blackwater (directly behind the Winn Dixie) that has been earmarked to become low income housing for 47 units may not be environmentally sound. This particular property, located at the entrance to Stillwright Point, MM 106, has a history. About 10 years ago, the owners tried to lease the property to Onyx as a waste transfer station (garbage dump) for hauling garbage from Islamorada to Miami. Stillwright Point residents fought against this land use on zoning violations and health and safety regulations and won. The Miami Herald ran a story on it.

At least as far back as 2005, the property was investigated (code enforcement) for illegally clearing land. See photos.

When the sewering of Key Largo began, the owners of the parcel contracted (and sub contracted) with the sewering companies (Rickman, Niko, Fountain, Redlands, C&W) as a staging area and a place to dump fill. The fill was supposed to be transferred to larger trucks and hauled away. This was dirty fill from trenching asphalt to lay the sewer pipes beneath Key Largo streets.

As more of the 2 North Blackwater property became cleared, neighbors reported seeing backhoes and bulldozers working nights and weekends, spreading the fill on the property.

In 2008, the property was red tagged by code enforcement officer Alan White for zoning violations and illegal fill and clearing of the property. An attorney serving on the KLWTD Sewer Board had previously represented the owners. He intervened on their behalf saying the County cannot red tag the County. The property owners never had a contract with Monroe County. They had a contract with a contractor who also had a contract with the County. The attorney said not allowing fill to be put on the property would hold up the sewer project. Alan White resigned from Monroe County Code Enforcement over this because he could not get anywhere on the obvious violations.

Twice this was supposed to go before the Special Magistrate (aka Code Enforcement Court) around 2009 and it was continually postponed. Code Enforcement required the fill to be hauled out in order for the property to be brought into compliance. The fill was spread at night and on weekends when County Code Enforcement officers were not working.

More protected mangroves and trees were cleared. As all the sewer pipe laying was finished and the trenching ended, the site ceased being used as a place to dump fill.

No permits for land clearing were ever issued. No permits for fill were ever issued. On tax records, this property was classified ""environmentally sensitive." No action was ever taken by the County against the owners for the blatant code violations. No action has ever been taken by the County to force the owners to restore the hammock and wetlands. God only knows what kind of toxic cocktail is in that fill!

The Gorman company is trying to purchase the property listed for \$1.8 million and use HUD funding to develop it into 47 low income units. If Monroe County makes them restore it, there will not be enough acreage to build the enormous housing complex.


learning ahead of her and desires to continue her art training in the years to come.


Key Largo Author Pens Young Adult Science Fiction Romance

It's November and that means turkey!

This year Thanksgiving is November 28th. On one of our most beloved holidays, when family and friends will join together to feast. My husband and I have spent many Thanksgivings on our 28-ft. sailboat. Preparing the traditional meal in tight quarters is a challenge and we have tried numerous ways... but one year I decided to cook turkey cutlets on the stove top. It was a delicious meal without the fuss of a whole bird. If you are looking for something different and easy, try this recipe. Enjoy, and happy holidays!

TURKEY CUTLETS MARSALA

- 2 large leeks- halved lengthwise and sliced
- 1/3 cup chicken stock
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1 bay leaf
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon dried thyme
- 1/4 teaspoon dried sage
- 1/4 cup sweet Marsala
- 2 tablespoons raisins
- 1 pound turkey cutlets
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon minced orange peel

Soak the raisins in the 1/4 cup Marsala. Combine the leeks (be sure to clean the leeks well and use only the white and light green part of the vegetable), chicken stock, sugar, bay leaf, thyme, and sage in a skillet. Season with salt and pepper. Cover and cook until tender, about 25 minutes. Uncover and cook until the leeks are golden brown. Remove from the skillet. Discard the bay leaf. Season the cutlets with salt and pepper and saute in the same pan until cooked through. Transfer the cutlets to a plate and cover to keep warm.

Return the sauce to the pan, add the Marsala with the raisins and the orange peel. Cook the sauce until it slightly thickens (about 2 minutes.) Spoon over the turkey and serve.



P.S. Sure is hot down here!


