Both emotional and physical pain are messages that we need to stop and pay attention.

first impulse is often to eradicate it with medication. 

Sometimes this is enough to noticeably reduce the pain because its message has been heard. Perhaps we seek to medicate pain because we fear that if we don't, it will never go away. It can be empowering to realize that, at least some of the time, it is just a matter of listening and responding.

The next time you feel pain, either physical or emotional, you might want to try listening to your own intuition about how to relieve your pain. Maybe taking a few deep breaths will put an end to that headache. Perhaps writing in your journal about hurt feelings will ease your
