


Dear friends,



Marriage Counseling in the Keys



The therapist turned to the husband and said, "This is what your wife needs at least 3 times a week. Can you do this?"


The husband replied, "Well, I can drop her off here on Mondays and Wednesdays, but on Fridays, I fish!"


