




Art Under The Oaks Art Festival Saturday, Jan. 18 at San Pedro

What Does It Take To Prevent Extinction of a Rare Orchid Specie

Ocean Life Series

After discovering that an extremely rare orchid was not flourishing in the Yachang Orchid Nature Preserve, Dr. Hong Liu launched a campaign to preserve the species. Considered extinct for 80 years, more than half of the area that hosted the only viable population had been illegally cleared for eucalyptus plantings by locals. Dr. Liu will discuss how she has tirelessly negotiated since 2008 with Chinese government officials to protect these plants and give scientists time to learn more about these rare plants and harvest seeds for future reintroduction, and to allow the habitat to recover. Britta began to take her ceramics and painting on the road exhibiting at art festivals and shows throughout south Florida and France. Her workshops became quite popular and fueled her art further.


After living in Key Largo for a few years Britta has become comfortable with calling this home. She still exhibits her work at events such as Art Basel in Miami but enjoys







Waves of Healing Ocean Meditation

When you feel you are finished, grant the ocean your earnest gratitude for the aid it has given you. Thank the sun, the sand, and any other elements of your visualization that offered you guidance.

Perform this meditation daily or monthly in order to rid yourself of negativity and reestablish emotional equilibrium. Just as the ocean's tides sweep the shores free of detritus, restoring balance, so can the waves in our mind's eve cleanse our souls of what no longer serves us.

It never fails. You sit down and light up a cigarette and suddenly there appears a cigarette bum. They won't spring for a pack of their own but they expect you to give them yours. It's rude and annoying! How can I keep people from grubbing ciga-

Dear Sick of Bums.

You are absolutely right to be anary. The US Congress just increased the tax on smokes from 39 cents to \$1.01 per pack* and they may be going up more. People are guarding their smokes

My advice is to get ruthless and rattle off all of the health risks of smoking. Tell them that what you do to your own body is your own problem, but that you refuse to destroy the health of others. If they choose to smoke they must buy their own poison.

However, medical studies have proven that you can still live with one lung and most forms of cancer are treatable at least for awhile. This is only one of hundreds of products that are slowly killing you. Smoking does not affect the



This month we should be experiencing some of the coldest weather of the year... but this year it can not seem to get out the high 70s or the low 80s. Still, January is a great time for a homemade soup. I love mushrooms and this is one of my favorite soups. Serve your soup with crackers or hot, fresh bread. Enjoy!

MUSHROOM BISQUE

 $4\frac{1}{2}$ cups chicken broth

1/3 cup butter

1/3 cup finely chopped onion

1/4 cup finely chopped celery

6 tablespoons all purpose flour

 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon crumbled dried thyme or 1 teaspoon of fresh

 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon chopped dried basil or 1 teaspoon of fresh

1/4 cup minus 1 teaspoon sherry

1 to 2 bay leaves

1 1/4 pounds sliced mushrooms

1 cup heavy whipping cream

1 tablespoon lemon juice

1 1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon white pepper

1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1/8 teaspoon hot pepper sauce

Bring the broth to a boil in a stock pot. Cover and set aside. Melt the butter in a frypan. Add the onion and celery. Sauté until translucent. Add the flour, thyme, and basil and stir 4 minutes. Whisk in the sherry. Mix into the hot broth and add the bay leaves. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat, simmer 3 minutes. Add the mushrooms and cook 20 minutes stirring occasionally. Stir in the remaining ingredients and simmer until sightly thickened, about 10 minutes. Serve.






Life's Lessons...






