Ocean Life Series

After discovering that an extremely rare orchid was not flourishing in the Yachang Orchid Nature Preserve, Dr. Hong Liu launched a campaign to preserve the species. Considered extinct for 80 years, more than half of the area that hosted the only viable population had been illegally cleared for eucalyptus plantings by locals. Dr. Liu will discuss how she has tirelessly negotiated since 2008 with Chinese government officials to protect these plants and give scientists time to learn more about these rare plants and harvest seeds for future reintroduction, and to allow the habitat to recover.
