### The Mangrove Galley by Sandi Mieszczenski

March is here and that means St. Patrick's Day. The traditional meal for the day is, of course, corned beef and cabbage. The meal consists of corned beef, cabbage, red potatoes (small, whole potatoes not peeled), carrots, and onions. Place the corned beef in a large

stock pot, cover with water and bring to a hard simmer with bay leaves and black peppercorns. Simmer for approximately 30 minutes a pound. The longer you cook, the more tender the meat becomes. Thirty minutes before serving remove the meat and cover with foil. Add the potatoes, carrots, and onion. Then add the cabbage the last twenty minutes. You can achieve the same effect by using a crockpot. Place the meat in the bottom of the pot, add water, bay leaves and peppercorns. Pile the vegetables on with the cabbage on top and let the meal slow cook all day.

If you are fortunate enough to have leftover corned beef there are many possibilities for leftovers. One of my favorite leftover dishes is shown at the right. Try it... and enjoy!

### HOMEMADE CORNED BEEF HASH

Serve this with poached eggs on an English muffin for a delicious breakfast!

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 3 cups potatoes, peeled and cut into 1/2 inch cubes
- 2 medium onions, peeled and sliced
- 3 cups corned beef, sliced with the grain, shredded and chopped
- 3 teaspoons garlic powder
- 2 tablespoons Worchestershire sauce
- fresh cracked pepper
- Tabasco sauce (optional)

Heat a large skillet on medium heat. Melt the butter in the pan. Add the potatoes and onion (be sure that you dry both well with a paper towel to avoid splattering.) Saute for 10 minutes. The potatoes should be slightly al dente. Add the corned beef, spices, and sauces. Mix well.

Saute, covered, for 25 minutes.

Stir occasionally.



Irving Reade Eyster passed away in February, at 95 years of age. A long-time resident of Islamorada, he is survived by his wife of 68 years, Jeane Eyster; three children: Robert (Sandy), Barbara Eyster Edgar (David), and David Eyster; and three grandchildren: Cinnamon Edgar, Veronica, and Evan Eyster. Irving was a friend to everyone he met.

Born in Indianapolis, Indiana, Eyster had resided in Lower Matecumbe since 1952 and had been a Keys resident since 1947. He taught archaeology at FIU and University of Miami; anthropology at Miami-Dade Community College and was a Dade County archaeologist for two years. He was a member of the Society of Professional Archaeologists and served on the Historic Florida Keys Preservation Board for 16 years. He was president of Matecumbe Historical Trust. His books include: Indian Key, Handbook of South Florida Archaeology, and Islamorada and More. His most recent book was Dr. Jeremiah Reade Explores Florida in 1882 -1883

Irving Eyster lived in and enjoyed the Florida Keys for over 60 years and dedicated his life to making the islands a better place for all. He accumulated countless friends during his impressive and captivating journey as an archaeologist and historian.


