Art Box Artist of the Month: Yvette Cotera

Yvette Cotera is a first generation Cuban-American born in Norfolk, Virginia. She has a past 35-year Hershey connection as her great-grandfather, grandfather, grandmother and five of her great aunts and uncles worked at the Milton Hershey's Sugar Central in Cuba.

Her mother and uncle were also both born in one of the Hershey town homes, which was modeled after the town in Hershey, PA. As her family traveled, Yvette spent her early years between Cuba, Virginia and Maryland in the US









before moving to south Florida where she has now lived for over 43 years. Inspired by her Caribbean island roots, the colorful tropics in Miami and her ocean home in Key Largo, Yvette creates sea life paintings that connect her to the many places of her life.

In 1978 she earned a degree in Advertising Design at the Art Institute of Fort Lauderdale, and was employed 4 years as a creative artist working at Tropix Togs and Wellington Apparel. There she designed whimsical art for apparel using licensed characters such as the Smurfs, the Jetsons, the Flintstones, Chilly Willy, Woody Woodpecker and Donald Duck. Her designs were sold all over the US!

While raising her 3 children, Yvette continued to work part time as a free-lance artist for over 6 years at Pffafco Inc. creating logos. She taught Art at St. Paul Lutheran K-8 School in Miami for over 4 years. Her art students participated and received awards in national duck stamp drawing contests, yearly school art shows and at the Miami Dade County Youth Fair.

Drawn toward the rewarding field of teaching, she returned to school, studied art history and computer art and earned her BA in 2010 at Miami Dade College in Exceptional Student Education.

Encouraged by her father, a doctor who passed away from MS, Yvette returned in 2013 to her passion of creating art. She is now affiliated with VSA Florida as a teaching artist and inspires people of all abilities to express themselves through the visual arts. Yvette has completed three visual art teaching residencies working with special need students. Many of her students have their work on exhibit; ask her where you can see it.

Yvette continues to grow as an artist and now takes her camera everywhere, including underwater, where she has taken images as inspiration for her paintings from her recent trips to Italy, Australia, New Zealand, Hawaii and the Caribbean Islands. Working from her home studio or plein air, she prefers to paint in mixed media using acrylics, water colors, dyes and inks on canvas and crescent acrylic board.



You can find Yvette at the Art Box teaching watercolor to children twice a month on Saturdays, as part of the kids' Saturday painting class (held every week, from 1:00 pm- 2:30 pm, for \$15). Look for Yvette's participation in the Art Box's upcoming Summer Program as well.







May is here and that means Cinco de Mayo. One of my favorite breakfasts is a perfect way to begin the Cinco de Mayo celebration: Huevos Rancheros.

This is a quick and easy dish and if you like eggs in the evening it makes a great supper.

HUEVOS RANCHEROS

¹/₂ cup chopped peppers (green, red, yellow, or combo) chopped cilantro

1 diced cubano pepper

1 small chopped onion

1 tablespoon butter

1 15-ounce can tomato sauce 1 teaspoon chili powder

1/2 teaspoon cumin

1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper

4 drops of Tabasco (or more if you like it spicy) 1 cup shredded Monterey jack

¹/₂ teaspoon paprika

4 flour or corn tortillas

sour cream

To prepare on stove top: Just assemble the ingredients in a large skillet then after adding the eggs, cover the pan until the eggs are set. Sprinkle on the cheese, cover the pan until it melts. Serve and enjoy!

To prepare in the oven: In a large skillet saute the peppers and onion in butter. Mix the tomato sauce, chili powder, cumin, cayenne pepper, paprika, cilantro, and Tabasco in a bowl. Prepare a baking dish with cooking spray. Pour in the tomato mixture. Break the eggs over the sauce. Sprinkle with the paprika. Bake in a 350 degree oven for 15 to 20 minutes until the eggs are set. While the eggs are baking, in a skillet lightly toast the tortillas on both sides. Keep the shells warm. After the eggs are set sprinkle the shredded cheese over the top and bake an additional 5 minutes. Place the eggs with the sauce over the top of the tortillas. Add a dollop of sour cream and serve. A side of chorizo (Spanish sausage) compliments the dish nicely.




