
Dear Ms. Malefyt:

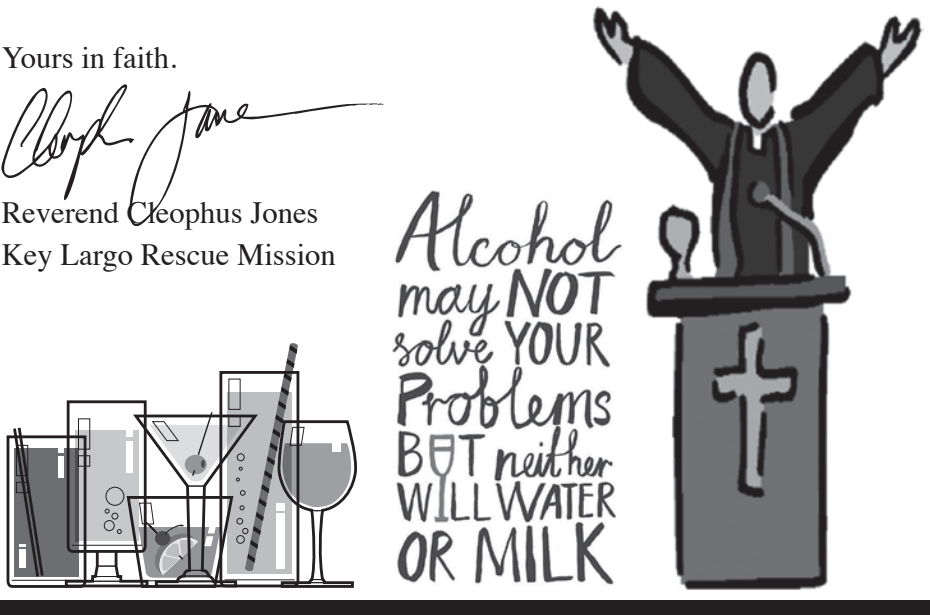


