September is here and boy... is it hot! A refreshing way to cool yourself off is with a nice cold dessert. This dish is easy to make and no baking is involved.

It is chocolate, and who does not love that? So non-bake away and enjoy!

Chocolate Truffle Loaf With Raspberry Sauce

2 cups heavy cream

3 egg yolks slightly beaten

2-8 ounce packages semi-sweet chocolate squares

1/2 cup Karo light corn syrup

1/2 cup butter

1/4 cup confectioners sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

Line a loaf pan with plastic wrap. Mix 1/2 cup of the cream with the egg yolks. In a saucepan cook the chocolate, corn syrup, and butter over medium heat until all is blended and the chocolate has melted. Add the egg mixture. Stir constantly cooking for 3 minutes. Cool to room temperature. Beat the remaining cream, sugar, and vanilla until soft peaks form. Fold into the chocolate mixture then pour into the loaf pan. Refrigerate until firm. Slice and serve with the raspberry sauce.

Raspberry Sauce

Puree in a blender or food chopper one package of frozen raspberries. Strain through a mesh colander to remove the seeds. Add 1/2 cup of sugar, mix and chill.
