All American Backcountry Tournament Will Benefit The Guides Trust Foundation

Cheeca Lodge & Spa, Islamorada's premier fishing destination, will host its Third Annual Cheeca Lodge All American Backcountry Tournament on November 13-15, 2014. This prestigious event draws discerning anglers from all over the world, and will raise funds for the locally-based Guides Trust Foundation.

Anglers will compete for trophies and prizes for releasing five different species of fish: snook, red-fish, bonefish, tarpon and permit. 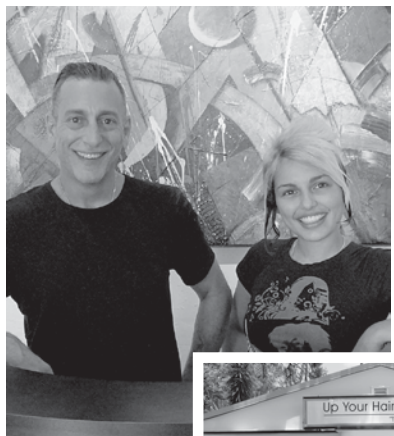

September is here and boy... is it hot! A refreshing way to cool yourself off is with a nice cold dessert. This dish is easy to make and no baking is involved.

It is chocolate, and who does not love that? So non-bake away and enjoy!

## Chocolate Truffle Loaf With Raspberry Sauce

- 2 cups heavy cream
- 3 egg yolks slightly beaten
- 2-8 ounce packages semi-sweet chocolate squares
- 1/2 cup Karo light corn syrup
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/4 cup confectioners sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Line a loaf pan with plastic wrap. Mix 1/2 cup of the cream with the egg yolks. In a saucepan cook the chocolate, corn syrup, and butter over medium heat until all is blended and the chocolate has melted. Add the egg mixture. Stir constantly cooking for 3 minutes. Cool to room temperature. Beat the remaining cream, sugar, and vanilla until soft peaks form. Fold into the chocolate mixture then pour into the loaf pan. Refrigerate until firm. Slice and serve with the raspberry sauce.

### Raspberry Sauce

Puree in a blender or food chopper one package of frozen raspberries. Strain through a mesh colander to remove the seeds. Add 1/2 cup of sugar, mix and chill.

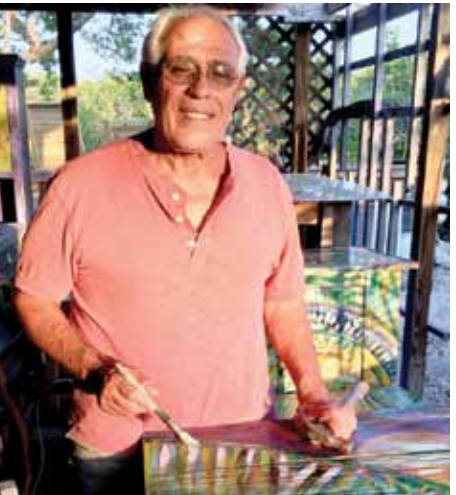

Here are some excerpts from Marty's bio:

"I was introduced at an early age to recycling. My dad was in the construction business, and my brother and I were his laborers. We cleaned the job sites, stripped the wood of nails and screws, and my father stored them for the next job.

"As a child, I learned to handle tools in wood shop. My father had wood working tools, and I used them to make benches, birdhouses and other simple projects. The local lumberyard let me forage their scrap wood.

"I always loved to draw and early on I could recreate all the Disney characters (I think there were only five, then); and I took art classes in school, through college. While I would have enjoyed

pursuing a career in art, my wife, Valli, and two sons required food, shelter and clothing on a regular basis; so I became a school teacher.

"I used to buy wood and make and paint odd pieces fashioned after country furniture. I found that in Monroe County there is a lot of discarded wood. An endless supply of raw materials is available to me; and the birds,



sea life, flora and fauna of the Keys give me an endless supply of subject matter.

"My craft enables me to recreate, recycle and restore the art that constantly surrounds us, which God gave us dominion over—the earth and all creation, the environment, His art."

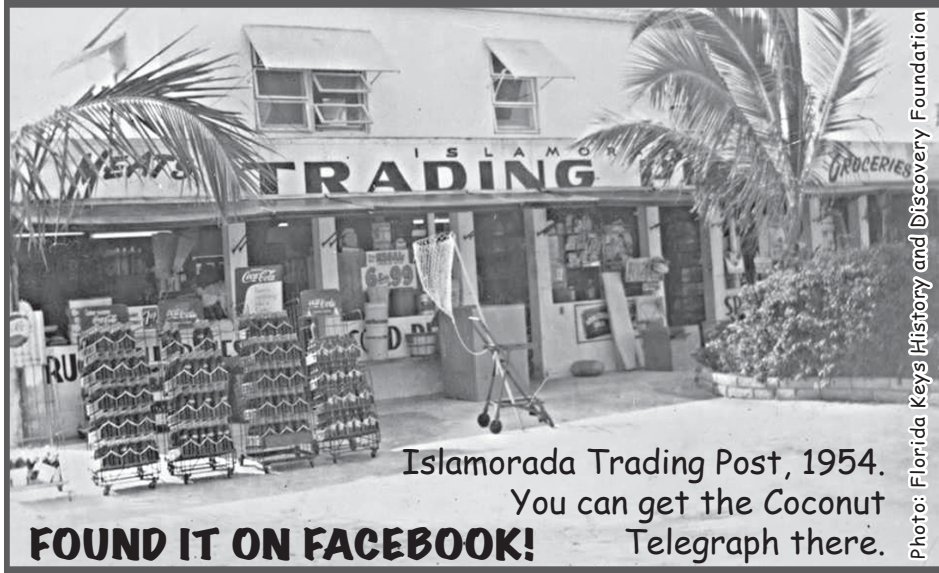

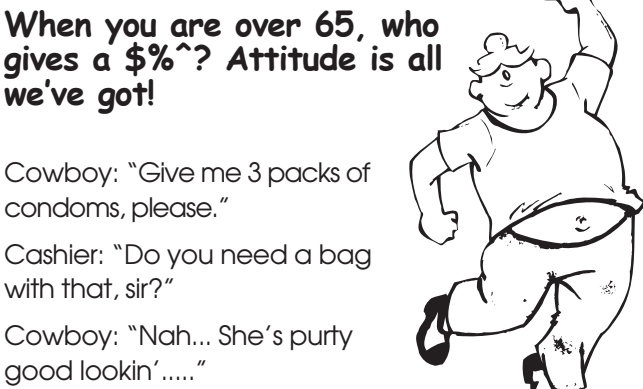

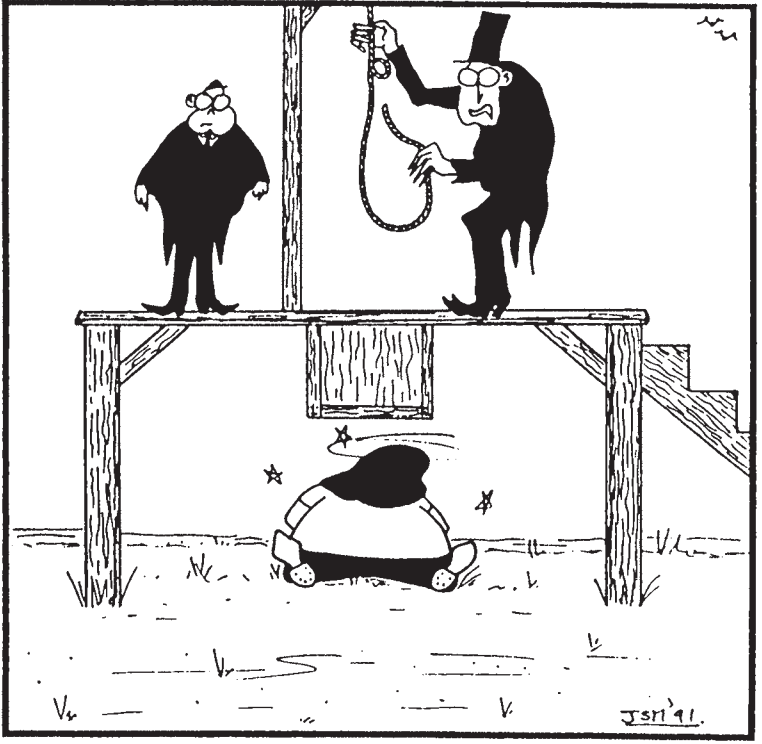
