



on a box belonging to Marr Properties! It wasn't even my box! They defaced someone else's property!


















Scam Busters!

Do not be a victim! The latest scams:

One of the more prevalent scams involves the caller saying they work for the IRS and a federal complaint has been filed against the victim. The scammer then says the victim can take care of the problem by making a payment immediately. The scammer tells the victim not to tell anyone about the scam due to security concerns and the scammer stays on the phone and walks the victim through the process of sending the money via Western Union to what turns out to be a fictitious bank account.

The other prevalent scam involves the caller placing a fake job ad on Craigslist where the victim has replied. The scammer and victim exchange a few emails then the scammer tells them they must send some sort of payment immediately or risk losing the job. The victim sends the money to the scammer and the scammer makes off with the money.

An electric company scam via phone wherein the scammer advises the victim that their utility bill is overdue and that payment must be made over the phone in order

to avoid the utilities being shut off.

An IRS scam via phone wherein the scammer advises the victim that they owe back taxes and that they must pay the overdue taxes with a credit card over the phone during that phone call or risk having the bank foreclose on the home the next day.

A Craigslist apartment scam wherein the scammer lists what appears to be a vacant apartment on Craigslist, waiting for someone to call about it, and then advises the caller that there has been significant interest in the apartment and that the only way to reserve it is to send money via Western Union immedi-

Consignment Shops - Do not leave your belongings without a signed copy of a list of your items. If you do not receive payment for your items or receive them back, call the Sheriff's Department.

If you have been the victim of any scam, call the Monroe County Sheriff's Department at 305-853-3211.

Art Box Artist of the Month: Ms. Donnie Spielman

Several months ago I took a wire-wrapping course offered at The Art Box. Donnie Spielman taught the class, and I left with a magnificent gemstone pendant I had created myself. You need not bring anything because it is all included in the price of the course; Donnie brings it all with her. Here is her story in her own words....

"This is a hobby that I totally love! It started almost 5 years ago when I began beading and then discovered the beauty of rocks and the awesome surprises that they hold inside. It started with tumbled rocks, then I bought a tumbler and started tumbling my own. From there I learned to cut or slab my own rocks and make cabochons. (Cabochons are stones that have a flat back and a smooth polished dome) They can be set by creating a bezel of copper or silver to set them in or wrapped with wire to make a pendant that can be hung from a cord or chain. Cutting, grinding and polishing a rock from start to finish is something that I find shuts my mind right down and relaxes me. Sometimes it seems I am a little out of place with my hobby down here in the Keys where everything is sand dollars and seahorses, fishing and everything having to do with oceans, boats and seafood, but this is my art and I love it. I also love creating beautiful pieces for others to wear, so I guess you could say I create wearable art."

Over the years Donnie taught herself and credits friends along the way for their help, for which she is grateful. "It is always challenging to learn something new and right now I am learning metal smithing. With metal smithing I am able to create bezels into which I can set my cabochons, or cabs as we call them. In working and forming the metal I am also able to add some forms of sea life to my art by using a rolling mill. So many new things to learn and so little time to play!"








sparkling clean and sanitary. When you visit you will

notice everyone is busy. No one is sitting down.

All the animals up for adoption are healthy and have all their shots and been vaccinated. No risk of taking home an animal that might infect your other pets.

They also operate as Animal Control. When a feral cat died on my dock, they disposed of it for me. They got called to a crazy animal hoarder's house. Feces 4" in cages. A total of 33 cats had to be euthanized because they were sick and/or in respiratory failure. Only a few recovered and were adopted.

Those of us who rememhere before Marsha took over remember the thousands of feral cats. You could Marr-velous Pets. "Sorry,"

not go to an outside restaurant without several sickly looking cats circling your table begging for food, and a day never went by where there wasn't at least 1 cat splattered on the highway. It was a big problem. Marsha's free spay and neuter clinic took care of it. The feral cats were trapped by volunteers, fixed by Marsha and taken back to where they came from. The feral cat thick on the floor, cats unfed population has been greatly reduced.

> My friend Mr. P's beloved dog named Bear got old. She was nearly blind and deaf. incontinent and could barely walk. She was suffering. Mr. P lives on a small fixed income and could not afford the veterinarian's euthanization fee of \$221. He called


they said, "we don't do that." He called Carla at the MM 102 Humane Society and she sent him to Marcia. There is no fee at the MM 106 UKHS. Mr. P gave them a small donation and Bear went over the rainbow bridge with dignity and love while we shed tears of sadness.

Marcia never turns an animal away. What do you think the mythical "No Kill" shelters do when an animal is sick and suffering? Sit and watch it suffer?

One time I stopped in to visit Marsha, The Fish House owner Doug Prew and his children were there volunteering. They cleaned cages and spent time with the animals. We need more people like that!







6 chopped dried apricots

1/4 cup thinly sliced celery

2 tablespoons chopped sweet onion

1/4 cup toasted almond slivers

Bake the breasts in a 375 degree oven until cooked through. Cool. (Can be prepared the day before.)

Cut the chicken into cubes. Mix the curry into the mayonnaise and add the chicken. Mix in the apricots, celery, and onion. Add salt and pepper to taste.

Rules For Bedroom Golf:



- 1. Each player shall furnish his own equipment for play, normally one club and two balls.
- 2. Play on a course must be approved by the owner of the hole.
- 3. Unlike outdoor golf, the object is to get the club in the hole and keep the balls out of the hole.
- 4. For most effective play, the club should have a firm shaft. Course owners are permitted to check shaft stiffness before play begins.
- 5. Course owners reserve the right to restrict club length to avoid damage to the hole
- 6. The object of the game is to take as many strokes as necessary until the course owner is satisfied that the play is complete. Failure to do so may result in being denied permission to play the course again.
- It is considered bad form to begin playing the hole immediately upon arrival at the course. The expe- 14. rienced player will normally take time to admire the entire course, with special attention to well formed bunkers.
- Players are cautioned not to mention other courses they have played or are currently playing to the owner of the course being played. Upset course owners have been known to damage players equip-

- ment for this reason. Players are encouraged to bring proper rain gear for their own protection.
- 10. Players should assure themselves that their match has been scheduled, particularly when a new course is being played for the first time. Previous players have been known to become irate if they discover someone else playing on what they consider to be a private course.
- Players should not assume a course is in shape for play at all times. Some players may be embarrassed if they find the course to be temporarily under repair. Players are advised to be extremely tactful in this situation. More advanced players will find alternative means of play when this is the case.
- The course owner is responsible for the manicuring and pruning any bush around the hole to allow for improved viewing of, alignment with, and approach to the hole.
- 13. Players are advised to obtain the course owners permission before attempting to play the back nine.
- Slow play is encouraged. However, players should be prepared to proceed at a quicker pace, at least temporarily, at the owners request.
- 15. It is considered outstanding performance, time permitting, to play the same hole several times in one match.
- 16. The course owner will be the solo judge of who is the best player.






