# About Crime Stoppers of the Florida Keys

Crime Stoppers of the Florida Keys is a communitybased program designed to help law enforcement solve crimes by rewarding anonymous tipster who supply criminal information that lead to arrests. The program can only hot line are passed on to the work through the combined efforts of the community, the media and law enforcement. Crime Stoppers is actually a non-profit corporation run by a civilian board of directors. The rewards are paid from donations raised by the board. Tax money is not used. Crime Stoppers is a successful local, state, national and international program.

#### How it works

Crime Stoppers operates a toll free number that is answered by trained staff members. Anyone who has information about a crime or a criminal can pass it on by

using the 24-hour hot line or by using the internet at www. tipsubmit.com. Tipsters may choose to remain anonymous. A code number is given to the

Any tips received on the appropriate law enforcement agency for investigation. If the tip results in an arrest, the independent civilian board of Crime Stoppers can give a reward of up to one thousand dollars. The tipster picks up the reward at a local financial institution by using the code number. The code number protests the anonymity of the tipster, which is essential to success of the program. The tip line is 1-800-346-TIPS (8477).

#### Crime Stoppers works!

There are hundreds of Crime Stopper programs in operation around the world. In Florida

there are 25 Crime Stopper programs serving all 67 counties. Locally, Crime Stoppers has been in operation in the Keys since 1992.

#### How can you help?

Since Crime Stoppers does not use tax money, donations are needed to help fund the reward program. A donation to Crime Stoppers is an investment in a safer community. Crime Stoppers gets criminals off the streets.

If you want to actively participate, Crime Stoppers always needs volunteers to serve as board members.







# The Mangrove Galley by Sandi Mieszczenski

The month of February brings one of our most loving holidays, Valentine's Day. It's a day of cards, flowers, champagne, and of course chocolates. This recipe produces a rich, brownie like chocolate concoction. I made it for a brunch but found that it is really more suitable for a dessert. Prepare it after a special Valentine's Day meal and let the romance begin. Enjoy!

#### **CHOCOLATE PANCAKES WITH STRAWBERRY SAUCE**

1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa powder 1-1/4 cup all-purpose flour 1 cup sugar 1/2 teaspoon baking soda 1/8 teaspoon salt

2 whole large eggs 1 large egg yolk

3/4 cup milk 1/4 cup vegetable oil 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 1/2 cup chocolate chips unsalted butter whipped cream

In a large bowl mix together the cocoa, flour, sugar, baking soda, and salt. Whisk in the eggs, egg yolk, milk, oil, and the vanilla until well blended. Stir in the chocolate chips. Place a pan on medium heat then add a pat of butter. After the butter melts, use a ladle to scoop the batter into the pan (my pan made four pancakes at a time.) If the pancakes run together just use a spatula to separate them. Cook the pancakes until bubbles appear on the top. Turn the pancakes and cook until they spring back when gently pressed. Pay close attention to the heat, as they can burn quickly. Remove from the pan and keep warm on a plate covered with foil. Prepare the pancakes in batches adding a pat of butter to the pan prior to a new batch.

#### Strawberry Sauce

This sauce can be used for many dishes including strawberry shortcakes and ice cream. Prepare the sauce before beginning the pancakes.

1 pound strawberries, washed, with the tops trimmed off 1/3 cup water

3 tablespoons (or more) sugar

Slice the berries. Place in a bowl, add the water and sugar. Mash, leaving some chunks. Stir, mixing well. Serve the pancakes with the sauce and a dollop of whipped cream.
