For reasons such as stress or information overflow your brain gets congested and the communication does not go through. Losing your train of thought is very similar. You are thinking too many things at once. The brain cannot compute and asks for a time out. Thus is the case of memory loss. It happens to all of us.

Here are the facts about memory and advertising:

(1) As we age our memory declines. Older people have more disposable income than young people. Older people eat out a lot, they shop, travel and read newspapers. When people read offline they tend to have longer attention spans. Internet reading is useful for gathering quick info but people tend to pay more attention to what they read in print.

(2) People forget what isn't in front of them. If you cancel an ad during a slow period, you will lose your momentum. It's like starting from scratch. It is better

The unique effects produced by layers of ever intensifying color, using wax as a resist to preserve light under-layers and then cracking the wax before removing it, are unlike those of any other kind of painting. There are always surprises. She has been teaching this technique successfully for years, most recently at The Art Box.

Gloria's portraits hang in several collections and appeared as author portraits on the covers of two

recent books. Most recently, one of her paintings was selected for publication in the Syracuse Cultural Workers' 2016 Women Artists Datebook (pictured at the left).

Ms. Avner's whimsical sense of humor comes through in her work. She also loves to paint people who impress her in her travels, like the young woman in the tiny village of Wat Opat, Recently, she has been creating drawings on an iPad, one more way to express her love of experimentation and diversity of creative play.














Deb McCoy: SeaShoreSeeds

Deb McCoy survived an aneurism several years ago and never thought she would have another one, yet just over a year ago she did. She awoke to find a room full of strangers surrounding her bed, her family!

Slowly her memory came back and while she was recovering at her son's house, her three adult sons Randy, Jack and Kyle, got together and repaired and prepared her home for her return.

Deb was "determined to recover," she says, "there is too much to live for" and she couldn't wait to get back to working with plants.

For the past eight years she has been working at Silent Native Nursery in the Redlands where they sell plants native to South Florida and the Caribbean native plants. Deb found

that there was also a need for seedlings of native plants. She began collecting seeds from the yards of her friends and started growing seedlings in 60-cell pack trays. And so Sea-Shore Seeds was born in Key Largo.

Deb mostly sells wholesale to nurseries who in turn sell to landscaping contractors who use them for restoration work, which ultimately helps the environment.

She also sells some stock retail; native plants and some tropical plants as well in 1,3, and 7-gallon containers. Her motto is to "cultivate for conservation meeting the needs of future generations."



One of my favorite shrimp dishes is coconut shrimp. This tasty dish is often served with a tangy sauce such as duck sauce or cayenne pepper sprinkled in an orange marmalade. This recipe is relatively easy to make and is great for boaters to prepare, as it is done on the stove top. Serve it as an appetizer or main dish. Enjoy!

COCONUT FRIED SHRIMP

24 large shrimp

2 beaten eggs (or 3, depending on the shrimp)

 $1\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons cayenne pepper

1 teaspoon salt

1 cup flour

3 cups dried breadcrumbs

1 cup shredded sweet coconut


Vegetable oil (cover the bottom of the pan with about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch)

Combine the eggs, cayenne pepper, and salt in a shallow dish. Place the flour in another dish. Then the breadcrumbs and coconut mixed together in a third dish.

Dredge the shrimp in the flour, shaking off any excess. Dip into the egg mixture then roll the shrimp in the breadcrumbs and coconut.

Heat the oil in a saute pan. Add the shrimp in batches as not to crowd the pan. Fry the shrimp for about 3 minutes, turn after browned and then brown the other side. Remove and place on a paper towel to absorb excess oil. Cover with foil to keep warm until all shrimp have been fried. Serve with a sauce.
