


Editorial continued

"Being a gal from Michigan, I'm an outdoors person as well as and artist from childhood. So when my husband planned for us to retire to the Keys, I couldn't have been happier! I wasn't prepared for the joy of living here in this rich, artistic culture. The beauty of the Keys is inspiring and I find there's not enough hours in the day to work on my art!" she exclaims.

A jack of all trades, Monica Bankowski works in and can teach numerous

painting and drawing media, and has extensive experience with printmaking, ceramics, photography, computer graphics, stained and fused glass, and even calligraphy. "When I was teaching high school art, I had two art rooms, one for fine art and a lab for digital art. I taught traditional black and white photography with a darkroom, then gradually went digital with the use of Adobe Photoshop. I now use it everyday."

Monica shares her passion of Photoshop on Monday evenings at The Art Box. Her class is offered through the month of March every Monday night from 6-8 pm. It's geared for beginners but those with some experience can bring their questions and projects to class for some tips on how to get the most out of Photoshop tools, drop down menus, and the palettes and layers. The class will also touch on the aesthetics and



ethics of photo editing. Pre-registration is required. As a teacher, Monica always believed that everyone is good at something. Although she left teaching in Ohio, here she continues to enjoy working with young people and has taught art at Coral Shores High School, substituted at PKS, KLS and TVM, and volunteered in the art department at Island Christian School. "I still believe in fun art and fine art, and art should be a fun experience based on solid art concepts. You can't teach art in the public school system for over 35 years without a sense of humor." One of her favorite quotes is from Albert Einstein: "Imagination is more important than knowledge."

Monica's artwork can also be seen at the Artamorada Gallery in the Rain Barrel. Her commissioned coconut paintings of client's pets and shoe painting designs are on display as



well as photographs, oil, acrylic and watercolor paintings, and artwork on tile.

Monica is an active member of the Art Guild of the Purple Isles of Key Largo, and attends Calvary Chapel; in Ohio she is a member of the Port Clinton Artists' Club and attends the Church of Middle Bass Island.

When not painting or teaching Monica enjoys boating and fishing with her husband Brad. In Ohio they are active members of the Middle Bass Island Yacht Club where she is volunteer photographer and co-editor of the MBIYC Member Directory/Yearbook.



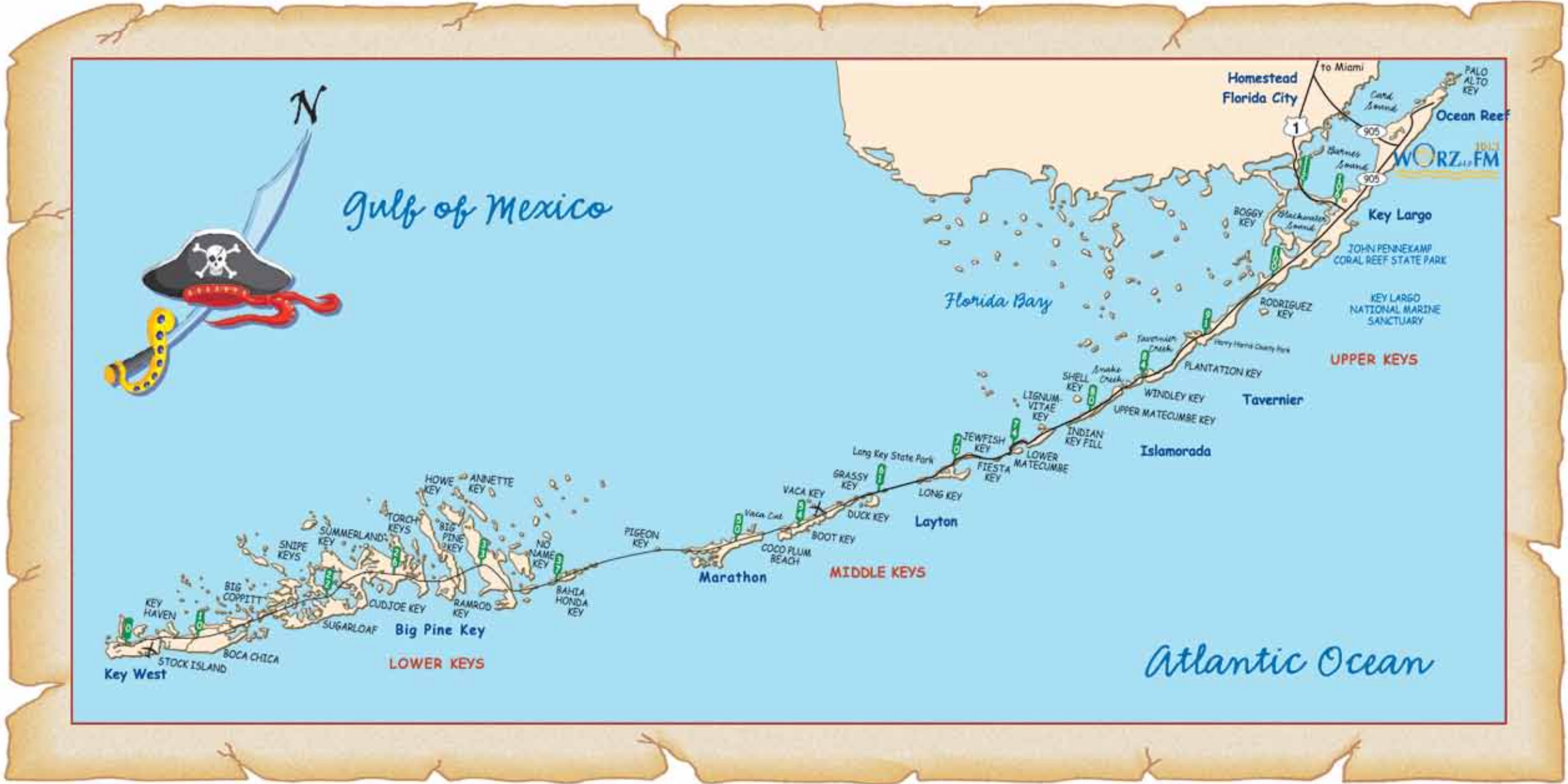

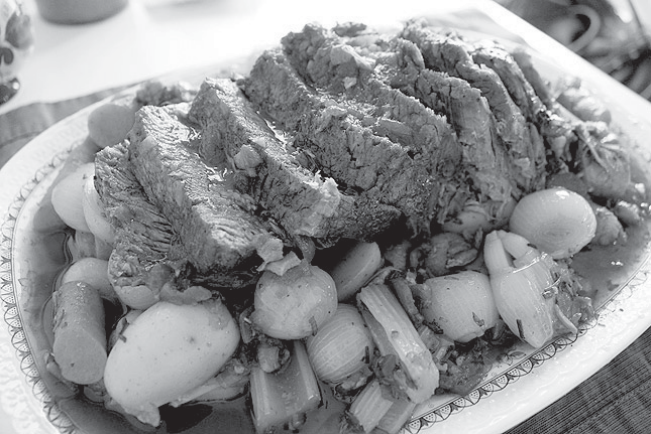

As we leave February and some of the coldest days of this year (burr!!!), we can look forward to the coming of spring, and weather that we Floridians are accustomed to. Of course March also means the celebration of St. Patrick's Day. Patrick is credited with introducing Christianity to the people of Ireland. Many places in the United States go all out with parades, green beer, shamrocks, and sightings of leprechauns (must have been too much green beer.) The traditional dish for this party day is usually corned beef and cabbage, but one year I tried something different: beef cooked in Guinness beer. It was delicious. So try the recipe for a St. Paddy's Day change, and enjoy!

BEEF IN GUINNESS

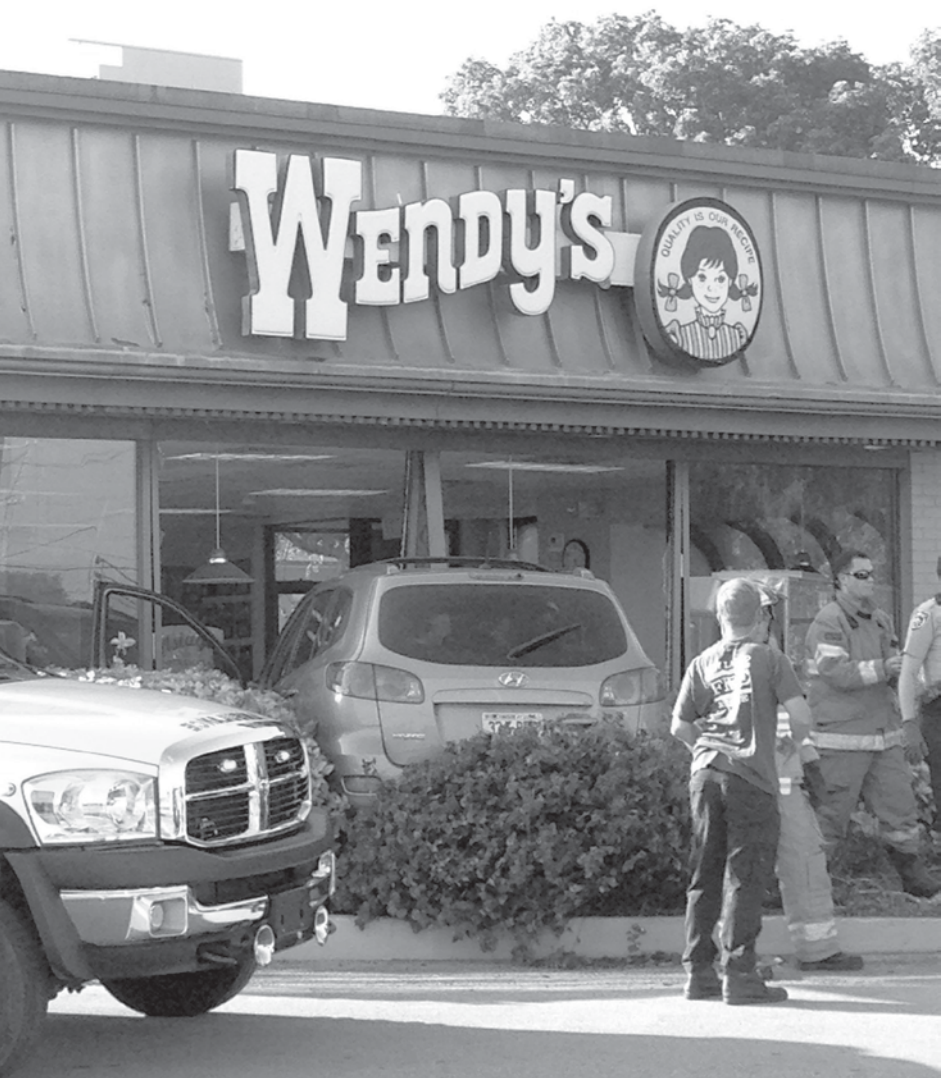
- 2 to 3 pounds chuck or pot roast
- 1 cup of flour
- salt and pepper
- 3 Tablespoons of vegetable oil
- 3 sliced onions
- 4 whole garlic cloves
- 4 sliced carrots
- 1 to 2 tablespoons fresh rosemary**
- 1 to 2 tablespoons fresh thyme**
- (**you may substitute 1 to 2 tsp. of dried)
- 2 ½ cups beef stock
- 2 bottles of Guinness



Cut the beef into 1" cubes. Season the flour with the salt and pepper. Roll the beef in the flour. Heat a large stock pot. Add the oil then the beef. After browning the beef add 1 of the sliced onions, 1 garlic, and 1 sliced carrot. Stir in the beef stock. Bring to a boil, cover, and reduce the heat to low. Cook for 1 ½ hours.

Add the Guinness, the remaining onions, garlic, carrots, and the herbs to the pot. Bring to another boil, reduce the heat to low and simmer 30 minutes. Remove the beef from the pot. On high heat, reduce the sauce by one half. Serve by pouring the sauce over the meat.

The beef dish pairs itself well with buttered boiled potatoes, a hot crusty bread, and a hearty red wine.

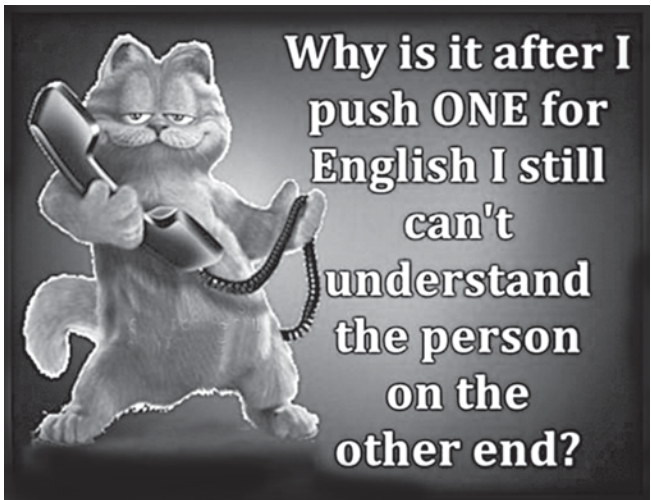

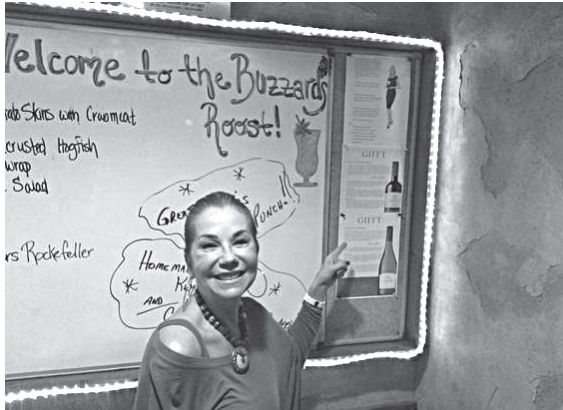
