A jack of all trades, Monica Bankowski works in and can teach numerous

painting and drawing media, and has extensive experience with printmaking, ceramics, photography, computer graphics, stained and fused glass, and even calligraphy. "When I was teaching high school art, I had two art rooms, one for fine art and a lab for digital art. I taught traditional black and white photography with a darkroom, then gradually went digital with the use of Adobe Photoshop. I now use it everyday."

Monica shares her passion of Photoshop on Monday evenings at The Art Box. Her class is offered through the month of March every Monday night from 6-8 pm. It's geared for beginners but those with some experience can bring their questions and projects to class for some tips on how to get the most out of Photoshop tools, drop down menus, and the palettes and layers. The class will also touch on the aesthetics and



ethics of photo editing. Pre-registration is required.

As a teacher, Monica always believed that everyone is good at something. Although she left teaching in Ohio, here she continues to enjoy working with young people and has taught art at Coral Shores High School, substituted at PKS, KLS and TVM, and volunteered in the art department at Island Christian School. "I still believe in fun art and fine art, and art should be a fun experience based on solid art concepts. You can't teach art in the public school system for over 35 years without a sense of humor." One of herfavorite quotes is from Albert Einstein: "Imagination is more important than knowledge."

Monica's artwork can also be seen at the Artamorada Gallery in the Rain Barrel. Her commissioned coconut paintings of client's pets and shoe painting designs are on display as



well as photographs, oil, acrylic and watercolor paintings, and artwork on tile.

Monica is an active member of the Art Guild of the Purple Isles of Key Largo, and attends Calvary Chapel; in Ohio she is a member of the Port Clinton Artists' Club and attends the Church of Middle Bass Island.

When not painting or teaching Monica enjoys boating and fishing with her husband Brad. In Ohio they are active members of the Middle Bass Island Yacht Club where she is volunteer photographer and co-editor of the MBIYC Member Directory/Yearbook.
