

Innocent Souls: Vietnam 1968

An exhibition of images captured by 1st Lieutenant Glenn Hoover in the Republic of South Vietnam in 1968 will be on display at the Key Largo Library Community Room for the months of November and December, 2015. Admission to the exhibition, "Innocent Souls: Vietnam 1968" is free and open to the public. An opening reception will be held on Sunday, November 8th from 3:00 - 6:00 PM. The Waypoint Foundation, a private not for profit devoted to celebrating human creativity and operating out of Key Largo is the primary sponsor of the exhibition.

This exhibition features photographs captured in 1968 during the peak of the conflict known by Americans as the Vietnam War and by Vietnamese as the American War. After sitting as slides in Glenn's closet for over 43 years, these images have taken on a new life on canvas. Some of these photographs are portraits of the Vietnamese and the Montagnards who lived there, while others are of the young American soldiers who were visiting.

Glenn arrived in Vietnam in January of 1968 through a series of voluntary choices, based on beliefs of service to his country instilled in him by his

father. Glenn, an Army ROTC graduate of Cornell University in Ithaca, NY, received a Silver Star, Bronze Star "V" Device, Army Commendation Medal and Combat Infantryman's Badge. He has worked years in the hospitality industry, owns Glenn Hoover Real Estate and lives in Key Largo, Florida.

Additional images by Glenn will convert the Womankind building windows at the corner of Truman Avenue and Eisenhower Drive in Key West into an art gallery to commemorate the dedication of the Vietnam Living Memorial in Bay View Park on November 11th. The project is sponsored in part by the Florida Keys Council of the Arts, the State of Florida, Division of Cultural Affairs, the Florida Council on Arts and Culture, the National Endowment for the Arts, The Waypoint Foundation, Womankind and private donations. Alan Kennish III of Key West Fine Art Photography and Printing has been commissioned to bring the compelling images to dramatic full-window size (approximately 8 feet x 7 feet). The images will remain in the windows throughout November and December.

Ms. Kim Romano, Executive Director of Womankind comments: "These images are stunning and the

production is superb. We at Womankind are pleased to have our windows transformed into gallery space. The gallery access is without doors and available 24/7. The transformation of this intersection is intended to pay tribute to American Vietnam Veterans."

According to Clarice Yentsch, the exhibition curator and President of the Waypoint Foundation, Inc,

"It is not the intent of this exhibition to be a documentary, nor to pass any moral judgments about this period. It is a series of snap shots taken during a brief moment, by one person. It is left to the observer to look through the eyes and into the souls of the subjects in hope that the images stir thought and encourage contemplation. If this happens, we will consider the exhibition a success."

Featured Artist of The Month: Jon Dreaver at The Art Box

Jon Dreaver, the owner of The Art Box with Key Largo Pack and Ship, has been selling art supplies, and mentoring up-and-coming artists, as well as teaching classes, tutoring, and helping give guidance to artists of all ages... for over five years.

When not in the shop, Jon is a board member for the education committee of the Art Guild of the Purple Isles, where he works with the schools, helping to find mentors and funding for various art-related school projects throughout the Upper Keys.

Jon moved to the Florida Keys over 10 years ago with his entire family to open the Key Largo Coffee House which is now the Key Largo Conch House, a family restaurant at MM 100.2 Oceanside. Jon envisioned a coffeehouse with Internet café travelers from all over the world and artists working off of easels in the courtyard.

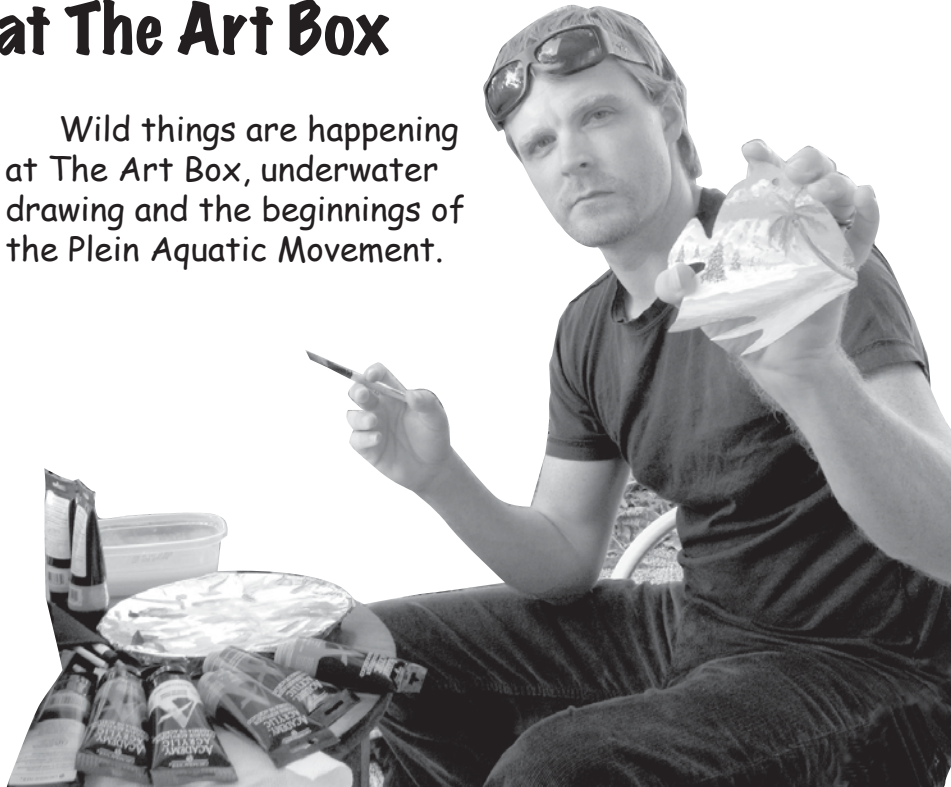
As the Coffee House turned more in the direction of a restaurant, Jon broke away from the family business with his wife Joanna, in pursuit of his vision for the arts in the Upper Keys by building an art store that could help the arts community. His store, The Art Box, has become a

staple in the Upper Keys for supplies and classes, and it has been a supporting member of the Morada Way Arts since its inception... as well as a supporter of the local art guilds and the Florida Keys Council of the Arts.

Jon's latest passion is the art of framing. As an artist, Jon has a genuine understanding of the difficulty artists face to present their work in an affordable fashion. So Jon began giving artist reviews for artists looking to learn how to price, present, and where they should focus their time displaying their work at shows, galleries, festivals, store fronts, or special events. Like many artists Jon struggles to find time to create for himself. More often than not he finds the only time to do art is when he's teaching a class. One of Jon's favorite classes to teach is The Wine & Paint class, for obvious reasons, which he teaches on Friday nights.

Jon recently teamed up with Lisa Mongelia with The History of Diving Museum and Jason Boone from Dive Documentaries to promote a new underwater sketchpad created by Boomer Gonzales of CMYK Printing Solutions called Tough Sketch. The team at Sailfish Scuba headed up the dive and this collaboration project called Underwater Portraits in Paradise had Jon sketching divers and reef scenes underwater at Molasses Reef by the winch hole and fire coral caves.

Wild things are happening at The Art Box, underwater drawing and the beginnings of the Plein Aquatic Movement.

According to Jon the newly repurposed paper performs well under all conditions above the surface and below, using graphite pencils. "This paper could revolutionize the plein air art movement and even start a new one we are calling Plein

Aquatic," said Jon. So if you need any help with your art, framing, need an art review, want to take classes, need supplies, or just want to meet an awesome guy, stop in at The Art Box and see what Jon can do for you.

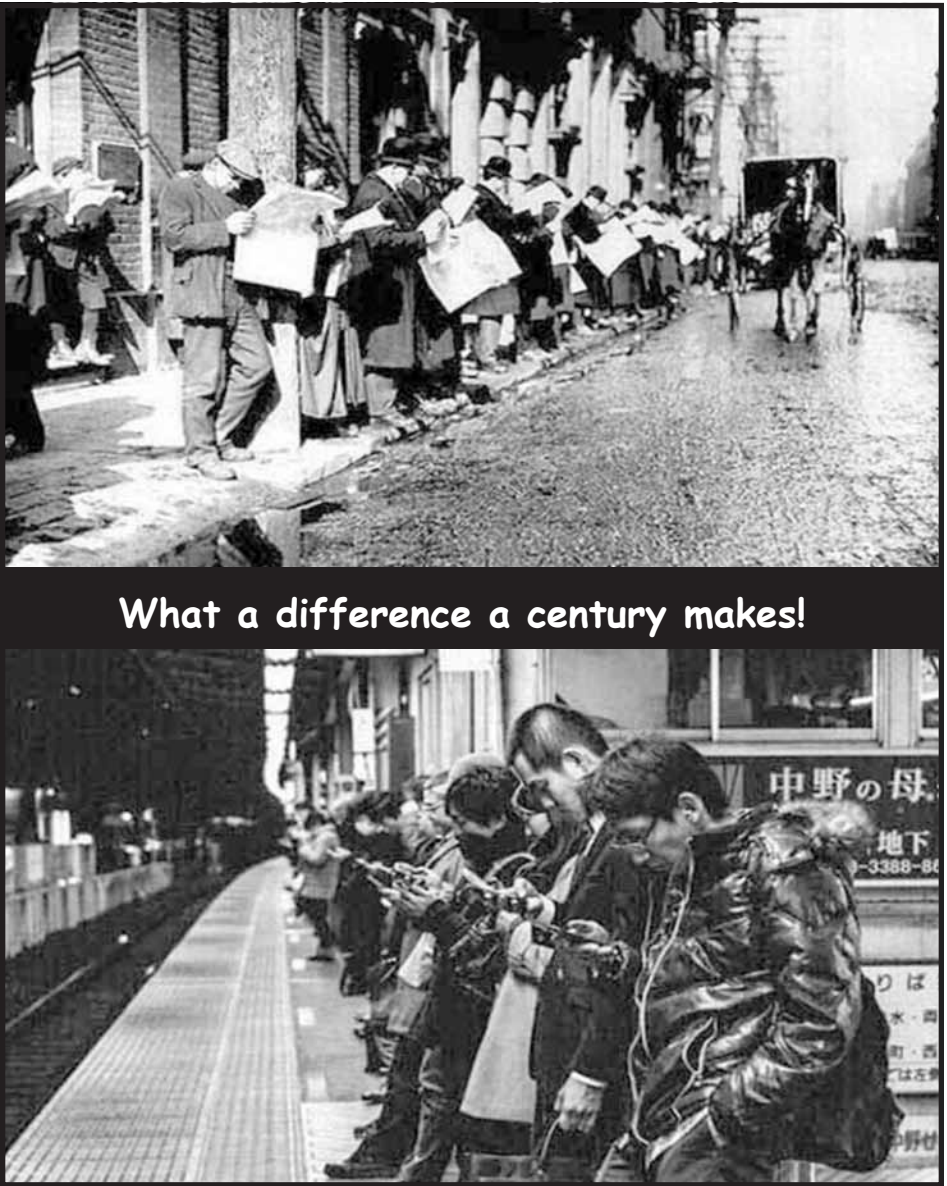

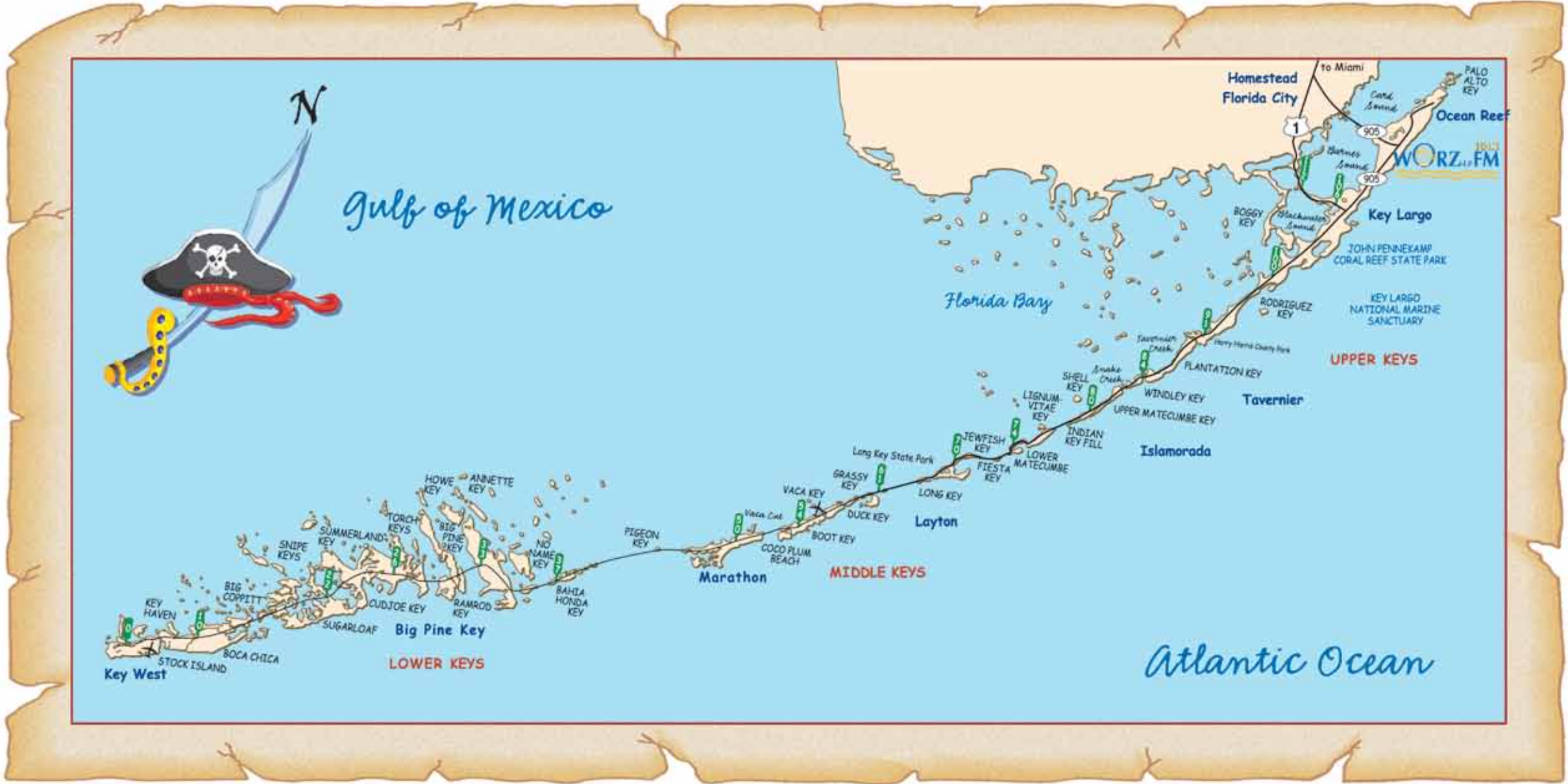

Well, it is almost here... Turkey Day! This year's Thanksgiving falls on November 26th. The feeding frenzy is the best of the season, indulging in a large juicy turkey with all the fixings. Without a doubt, the delectable, prime cut breast meat will disappear quickly at the table. Now, what to do with any leftover meat? Turkey freezes extremely well, so divide what is left and save for future meals. Boil the carcass with herbs and vegetables and you have a perfect broth for soup. Try the recipe printed here and I promise that you won't hear that old disgruntled phrase, "turkey, again?" **Have a great Thanksgiving!**

MEXICAN TURKEY SOUP

- 4 cups turkey broth made from the leftover carcass (or chicken broth)
- 3 teaspoons chili powder (add more for a spicier soup)
- 2 teaspoons cumin powder
- 1 minced fresh jalapeno pepper, seeds removed (more depending on your heat preference)
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh cilantro
- 3 finely minced medium garlic cloves
- 2 medium diced onions
- 1 29-ounce can diced tomatoes
- 1 10-ounce package frozen corn
- 1 16-ounce can drained and rinsed pinto beans
- 3 cups diced leftover turkey
- salt and pepper to taste
- corn tortilla shells
- butter



In a stock pot, combine all of the ingredients except for the tortilla shells. Bring to a boil, lower the heat and simmer covered for 1/2 hour. Slice tortilla shells into strips. Brown on both sides in a saute pan with the butter. Ladle the soup into bowls and serve with the tortilla strips across the top.
