2 pork cutlets (a boneless pork chop) salt & pepper


- $3\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoons unsalted butter, divided
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoons olive oil
- 1 large ripe pear, cored and thinly sliced
- 1 tablespoon fresh minced thyme (or 1 teaspoon dried)

Flatten the pork and salt and pepper both sides. Melt $1\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoons of the butter with the olive oil in a sautee pan. Add the pork browning both sides and cook completely. Transfer the pork to a platter covering to keep warm. Add the pear slices to the pan and saute them until they are light brown (about three minutes.) Add the thyme and garlic cooking one minute. Pour in the vinegar deglazing the pan by scraping up the brown bits. Mix in the stock and brandy. Simmer until the sauce is slightly reduced (about 3 minutes). Whisk in the remaining butter then return the cutlets to the pan until heated through. Serve with fresh thyme leaves as a garnish.

The Process of Grieving **Becoming Whole Again**

Grief can arise from many life situations, but know it is not a permanent state of being.

When we experience any kind of devastating loss, whether it is the loss of a loved one, a dream, or a relationship, feelings may arise within us that are overwhelming or difficult to cope with. This sense of grief can also come up when we are separated from anyone or anything we have welcomed into our lives.


