- 1 guart of high guality vanilla ice cream

On medium low heat, brown the coconut in a sauté pan. Watch carefully, stirring constantly as it can burn quickly. Combine the butter, sugar, rum, and cinnamon in a saucepan. Cook while stirring until the mixture begins to boil. Remove from heat then add the sliced
