

Editorial: Fallout from Last Month's Issue and the Election

Dennis Ward defeated State Attorney Catherine Vogel in the November election by a small margin. Ward admitted to the press that he had phoned Madruga and fired him just prior to Madruga's suicide. Ward then went on to trash the entire State Attorneys office. Catherine Vogel, Manny Madruga and the entire State Attorney's office have

done an excellent job for us. Many of the great people employed there chose to support their boss,Vogel, and therefore are afraid that they too will be fired by Ward in a tirade of vindictiveness.



The Beach Was Too Sandy

Now that season has started... We know you'll enjoy these tourist complaints compiled by Trade Dick:

1. "On my holiday to Goa in India, I was disgusted to find that almost every restaurant served curry. I don't like spicy food."



Homelessness Prevention in the Upper Keys

The Florida Keys Outreach Coalition, Inc. (FKOC), expanded services to the Upper Keys in October of 2015, opening an Outreach Office in Tavernier to better serve all of Monroe County.

With the support of many wonderful community partners FKOC has been able to provide critical assistance to help keep friends and neighbors from becoming homeless.

In the past year they have helped elderly residents pay utility bills, provided work clothing for the newly employed, helped working families struggling to pay rent, provided food for people finding their income has fallen short of their expenses, paid day care expenses and medical co-pays.

In partnership with the Upper Keys Community Resource Council (UK CRC), FKOC will be hosting a fundraiser "Santa's Stop, Shop, & Sip" to support homelessness prevention services in the Upper Keys on December 10th, see the ad for details.

They are seeking donations for all of these different activities but especially for the silent auction. Contact FKOC at (305) 916-5454 to help.

FKOC is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization and your donation is tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

All proceeds from the above-listed activities will go to providing homelessness prevention services in the Upper Keys that keep our friends and neighbors housed and fed.

"We know that sometimes a quick, helping hand can catch someone before they fall into homelessness." The coalition asks others for their help and support in these efforts.

The coalition thanks the Key Largo Lions Club, The Key Largo Chamber of Commerce, Coral Isles Church, Printing Plus, Key Largo Chocolates, The Fish House/Encore, Shell World, The Art Box, Bifton Bistro Cafe, and all of the auction and financial donors who have given so generously to make the Dec. 10 event possible.

OUTREACH/MAINSTREAM RESOURCES: On-going outreach efforts assisting with Food Stamp (SNAP) applications, SSI/SSDI applications, assistance accessing to ACA, Medicare/Medicaid assistance and financial, housing and employment counseling.

HOMELESS PREVENTION SERVICES: Temporary rental and mortgage payment assistance and assistance to those living on boats to ensure habitability standards are obtained or maintained to remain housed. Call for availability.

One of my favorite holidays is Christmas. It is a great time of the year to share with family and friends. I love serving a Christmas brunch. Last year, I made shrimp and grits which was a big hit. Since shrimp is so abundant in the Keys, this recipe (which is relatively easy to make) is a perfect dish to start the holiday. Try the recipe; I am sure that you will enjoy it. Happy holidays!

SHRIMP AND GRITS

- 3 cups chicken broth
- 2 cups half and half
- 2 ½ cups of grits (yellow grits if you can find them; Do not use instant grits)
- 2 cups grated sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 ½ pounds of peeled and cleaned shrimp
- 2 andouille sausages
- 1 cup thinly sliced green onions
- Salt and pepper to taste

Slice the andouille sausages into ¼ inch thick rounds and then cut the rounds in half. Heat until cooked through. Place on a paper towel and drain the fat from the pan. Lightly sauté the shrimp in the same pan and remove when just pink.

Bring the chicken broth to a boil. Add the half and half and reduce to a simmer. Slowly add the grits, stirring constantly. If you add the grits too quickly, it will result in messy clumps. Cover the pan and cook five to six minutes. Stir occasionally. Add the cheese, mixing well. Stir in the shrimp and sausage and let simmer until well heated. Serve with the green onions on top.

This recipe will serve four people.
