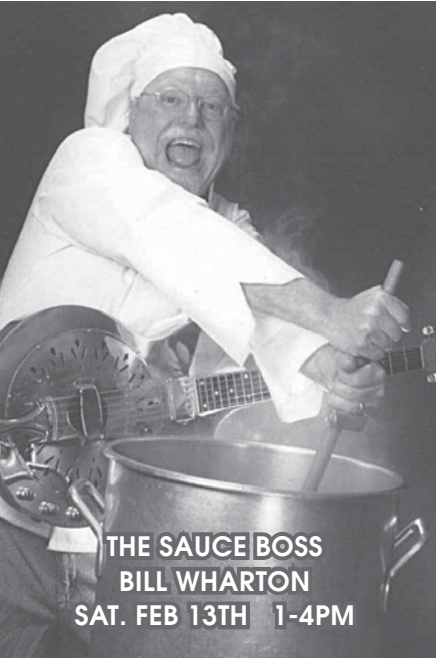

**Best of Both Worlds... at Gilbert's**



One morning in the early '70s, the Sauce Boss walked out of his house and found a 1933 vintage National Steel guitar in his front yard. That led him down the Blues path. Deep in the shed, he penned "Let the Big Dog Eat," which was featured in Jonathan Demme's film "Something Wild." Years later he combined his blues with his hot sauce in a big pot of gumbo, made right on stage. Singing the recipe, he mixes his music and cooking together into a new medium. Since 1990, the Sauce Boss has cooked gumbo for over 200,000 people, all for free, while simultaneously playing his own swampy Florida blues. A Sauce Boss event transcends performance. It's a soul-shouting picnic of rock and roll brotherhood, involving everyone. And at the end of the show, everyone eats.

Red Elvises began in 1995 after Igor dreamed that Elvis Presley came to him and told him to

start playing rock'n'roll. Not one to say no to the King, Igor and his Russian friends started playing on Santa Monica's 3rd Street Promenade. Their street musician days did not last long, however, as they drew such huge crowds that the City of Santa Monica brought them to court and ordered them off the streets. Since then Red Elvises have been constantly touring, with occasional breaks from the road to record an album or take part in film and television projects. This constant work for the last 15 years has led to them gaining a world-wide following, with successful tours all over North America, Europe and Russia (Red Elvises bootlegs have been found in Siberia).
