

# Hurricane Season is Over. Prepare for the Zombie Apocalypse Now!

This just in, from the CDC: Office of Public Health Preparedness and Response (no joke!)

There are all kinds of emergencies out there that we can prepare for. Take a zombie apocalypse for example. You may laugh now, but when it happens you'll be happy you read this, and hey, maybe you'll even learn a thing or two about how to prepare for a real emergency.

Where do zombies come from and why do they love eating brains so much? The word zombie comes from Haitian and New Orleans voodoo origins. Although its meaning has changed slightly over the years, it refers to a human corpse mysteriously reanimated to serve the undead.

In movies, shows, and literature, zombies are often depicted as being created by an infectious virus, which is passed on via bites and contact with bodily fluids. The Zombie Survival Guide identifies the cause of zombies as a virus called solanum. Other zombie origins shown in films include radiation as well as mutations of existing conditions such as prions, mad-cow disease, measles and rabies.

The rise of zombies in pop culture has given credence to the idea that a zombie apocalypse could happen. The proliferation of this idea has led

many people to wonder "How do I prepare for a zombie apocalypse?"

Well, we're here to answer that question for you, and hopefully share a few tips about preparing for real emergencies too!

So what do you need to do before zombies...or hurricanes or pandemics for example, actually happen?

First of all, you should have an emergency kit in your house. This includes things like water, food, and other supplies to get you through the first couple of days before you can locate a zombie-free refugee camp (or in the event of a natural disaster, it will buy you some time until you are able to make your way to an evacuation shelter or utility lines are restored). Below are a few items you should include in your kit, for a full list visit the CDC website.

- Water (1 gallon per person per day)
- Food (stock up on non-perishable items that you eat regularly)
- Medications (this includes prescription and non-prescription meds)
- Tools and Supplies (utility knife, duct tape, battery powered radio, etc.)
- Sanitation and Hygiene (household bleach, soap, towels, etc.)
- Clothing and Bedding (a change of clothes for each family member and blankets)
- Important documents (copies of your driver's license, passport, and birth certificate to name a few)
- First Aid supplies (although you're a gonner if a zombie bites you, you can use these

supplies to treat basic cuts and lacerations that you might get during a tornado or hurricane).

Once you've made your emergency kit, you should sit down with your family and come up with an emergency plan. This includes where you would go and who you would call if zombies started appearing outside your door step. You can also implement this plan if there is a flood, earthquake, or other emergency.

Identify the types of emergencies that are possible in your area. Besides a zombie apocalypse, this may include floods, tornadoes, or earthquakes.

Pick a meeting place for your family to regroup in case zombies invade your home...or your town evacuates because of a hurricane. Pick one place right outside your home for

sudden emergencies and one place outside of your neighborhood in case you are unable to return home right away.

Identify your emergency contacts. Make a list of local contacts like the police, fire department, and your local zombie response team. Also identify an out-of-state contact that you can call during an emergency to let the rest of your family know you are ok.

Plan your evacuation route. When zombies are hungry they won't stop until they get food (i.e., brains), which means you need to get out of town fast! Plan where you would go and multiple routes you would take ahead of time so that the flesh eaters don't have a chance! This is also helpful when natural disasters strike and you have to take shelter fast.



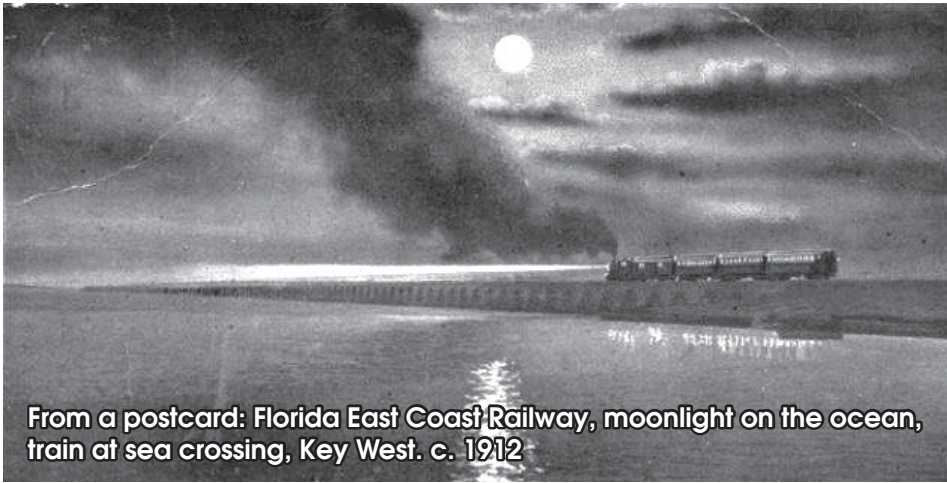
# Women’s Group to Meet Locally



# Featured Artist of The Month: Larry Young

Our featured artist this month has his work on display at the Art Box, MM 100.6 Bayside, Key Largo. In his own words:

“It all started with my cowboy coloring books. I still remember coloring them in analogous schemes of blues or greens. Next came kindergarten and a huge drawing of Flash Gordon-like spaceship that used up almost all of my black crayon. In high school it was the big-eyed waifs, and then I discovered Jackson Pollack and the world of American Expressionism. Our home had a huge Pollack painting over the couch. I was forever hooked on abstract painting.

“My choice, when I started at the University of Tennessee, was Art or Law. The romance of a starving artist lost out and I eventually became a prosecuting attorney for the State of Tennessee.

“Over the years I would be drawn back to my creative urge and would attend workshops for figure painting, landscapes, and abstract

painting. When I retired, I completed all the drawing and painting courses at UT Chattanooga fine arts department.

“My paintings in recent years often blend my urge to abstraction with landscapes and seascapes to create compositions that mix elements of mood, color, and composition to produce my own style, admittedly drawing from influences of masters such as William Turner, post impressionist, and abstract painters of the '60s.

“For the last several years I have been a permanent contributor to a gallery of contemporary art producing suites of abstract work. Two years ago I decided I wanted introduce discipline back into my work and left acrylics for oils and painted with plein-air artists. This summer I attended two plein-air workshops in northern Michigan and made a number of paintings.

I paint as a hobby. I am rewarded when someone buys a painting, not from the

In the 18th century great clipper ships and merchant vessels from the American colonies would visit the West Indies islands and return with different exotic fruits including the pineapple. Captains and sailors would display a pineapple over their door as a sign to their friends and neighbors signifying that they had returned home safely and visitors were welcomed. Thus, the pineapple became a sign of southern hospitality. The gift of a pineapple was most coveted.

## PINEAPPLE UPSIDE DOWN CAKE

This cake will just melt in your mouth!

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1 large can sliced pineapple rings, in juice
- large, whole pecans
- 1 cup sifted cake flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3 eggs, separated
- 1 cup sugar
- 5 tablespoons pineapple juice (drained from the can)

Melt the butter in a 9x9x2 inch pan. Spread the brown sugar evenly in the pan. Arrange the pineapple rings on the sugar. Place the pecans around the rings.

Sift the cake flour, baking powder, and salt together. Beat the egg yolks until light, add the sugar gradually. Add the pineapple juice and sifted dry ingredients alternately to the egg yolk mixture. Mix well after each addition.

Beat the egg whites until stiff. Fold them in the mixture. Pour the batter over the pineapple in the pan. Bake in a 375 degree oven for 30 to 35 minutes. Let cool 10 minutes then turn on to a serving dish.

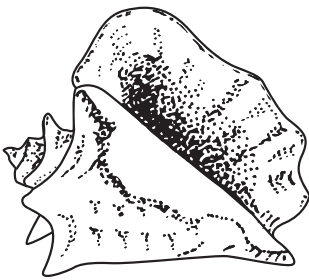

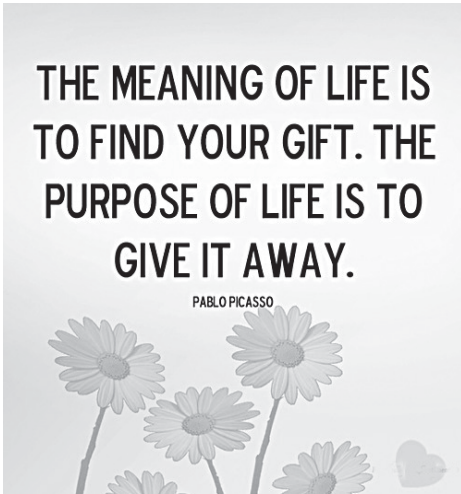

Relationships can become out of balance and one-sided if we don't occasionally check in with each other.

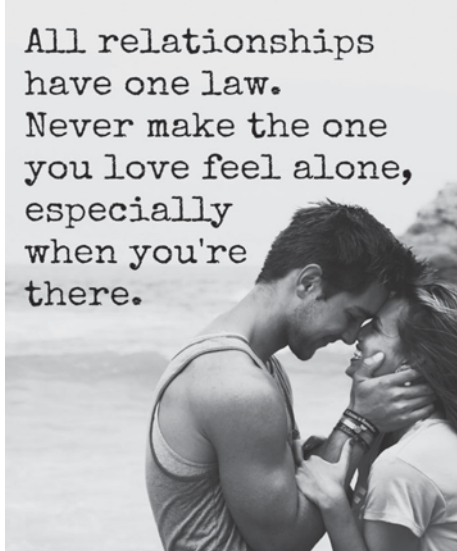


One of the most beautiful qualities of an intimate relationship is the give and take of energy that occurs between two people. In the best-case scenario, both people share the talking and listening, and the giving and receiving of support, equally. One example of this is a mentor relationship in which you are learning from someone. Another example is a relationship in which you are helping someone who is sick, disabled, or otherwise needy. In these instances, you can simply be grateful that you are able to help and be helped, trusting that the balance of give and take will even out in the big picture of your life.
