

They deal with drunk customers who run up to the stage spilling their drinks on them yelling "Play Freebird, dammit!" or "let me sing a sona!" If the weather report is predicting rain, their gig may be cancelled and they don't get paid after lugging all their equipment to the venue. If they get sick or hurt and cannot work, they are at the mercy of their friends to help. Performers rarely have a backup plan. Most of these entertainers are the first to volunteer their services when needed for a benefit



I have had a extremely painful torn sacroiliac tendon and I'm wearing a back brace that slows me down but I still managed to get it done. 





Robert "Bobbe" Brown, one of three musically gifted brothers, moved to Key West in 1985, after a chance meeting and hiring by the owner of Sloppy Joe's in an

airport bar. For most, this would be their "bia break" but Bobbe had already played in Mickey Gilley's band, played with BB King, Charlie Daniels, Vince Gill, Marshall Tucker, and Bonnie Raitt.

In 1981, Bobbe won a Country Music Award, an Academy of Country Music Award, and even a Grammy for his song "Orange Blossom Special" which was on the second "Urban Cowboy" movie album.

Bobbe left Texas in 1985 with his cowboy hat and boots, guitar in hand, and started the longest string of employment in Key West history. For 10 years, Bobbe played Sloppy Joe's every afternoon, 7 days a week, and when he wasn't playing nights at Margaritaville or the Green Parrot, he was

drinking with his buddies Mel Fisher and Captain Tony Terracino at PT's.

One evening he played his blues version of Margaritaville for Jimmy Buffett himself. Jimmy liked the version so much, that he brought Bobbe to his recording studio to get it on tape.

After 10 years of partying like a rock star, and managing to stay out of serious trouble, Bobbe packed up and headed north... and he calls the Upper Keys his home

Bobbe says that Billy Gibbons (quitarist for ZZ Top) is the most wellrounded guitar player he has ever seen, and the two have been friends for over 30 years.

Bobbe would have loved to open a concert for Prince, because he was one of the best guitarists in the world.

And Bobbe would love to go on tour with Katy Perry, because "she's hot."

Bobbe enjoys playing rock and roll, and describes his music sound as "rockin blues with a country feel." When he has a free night, he enjoys eating at Waffle House in Key Largo, because everything is "scattered, smothered and covered."

How Were The Elks Formed?

In New York City, a small group of actors and entertainers, wishing to continue their social gatherings on Sundays, when New York's blue laws prevented the opening of public establishments, began to meet regularly as the "Jolly Corks," a name derived from a bar trick introduced by the group's organizer. While the meetings were held with regularity, apparently no form nor substance resulted, except for the adoption of a toast to members of the group not in attendance. Shortly before Christmas in 1867, only a few months after the fellows began to meet, one of their number died, leaving his wife and children destitute.

addition to good fellowship, the Jolly Corks needed a more noble purpose in order to endure, and serving not only their own in need, but others as well, would be appropriate. Two months later, on February 16, 1868, with a statement of serious purpose, an impressive set of rituals, a symbol of strength and majesty and such other elaborate trappings that might be expected of a group of actors and musicians, the new fraternal order was launched.

When we pulled them out I had suggested doing a mock Salisbury Steak. What we put together was delicious and so easy. It is a great meal for boaters. Enjoy!

GALLEY SALISBURY STEAKS

1 pound ground beef

1 egg

To prepare the burgers, mix in egg, salt, pepper, and garlic powder to taste. Then form into patties.

For the sauce-

2 tablespoons butter

1 medium to large onion, sliced

8 ounce mushrooms, sliced

1 can of Golden Mushroom soup

 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup red wine

1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

Using a large skillet, cook the hamburgers until brown on both sides, turning once. Remove the burgers and set aside. Clean the pan of excess grease. Add the butter to the pan and sauté the mushrooms until they just start to soften. Set aside the mushrooms and saute the onions until soft. Add the can of soup, wine, and Worcestershire to the pan, return the mushrooms and mix throughly. Bring to a bubble and reduce the heat to simmer. Place the burgers back into the sauce, cover and cook for 10 to 15 minutes. Can be served alone or over noodles.




With the mobile kitchen that rivals that of her own restaurant and a staff that is larger by half, Laura Dreaver is the Upper Keys name for catering.
