

He loved the outdoors and was always on the go pursuing a daily outdoor activity and enjoying life to its fullest.



In 1995, shortly after his father's passing, while fishing with friends in Florida, Wade purchased his boat rental business, Reef Rentals, at the Ocean Reef Club.
