



## Remembering Kay Thacker

Long-standing community leader and good friend to many, Kay Thacker passed away in late February after a courageous battle with cancer. She was a strong woman, smart and gutsy, and she will be greatly missed for all she did and all she gave.

Born in 1945 in Pikeville, KY, Kay moved to Indiana in 1950, and raised her family in Greenwood, IN. She had been coming to the Keys since 1965 and moved to Key Largo permanently in 1989.

Kay's parents were Gene and Carolyn Damron, who preceded her in death. She is survived by her husband, John Groothand, her sons, Tim Thacker, of Jacksonville, FL and Todd Thacker, of Lake Mary, FL and her daughtersin-law Carrie and Danielle, her half brothers, Gene Damron and Gary Hunt, and her half sister Nancy Taylor. She had 7 grandchildren: Sarah, Jacob and Cole Ponder, Emma, Kylie, Mathew and Elizabeth

Kay had a passion for Key Largo and Monroe Co., and was very involved in the inner workings of the local government while being a frequent contributor to the editorial section of our local papers. She spoke truth to officials as she saw it, she to spoke on behalf of many residents. Kay was the President of Friends of the Key Largo Cultural Center, VP of External Affairs for Island of Key Largo Federation of Homeowners, and Secretary of Sexton Cove Property Owners Association.
