

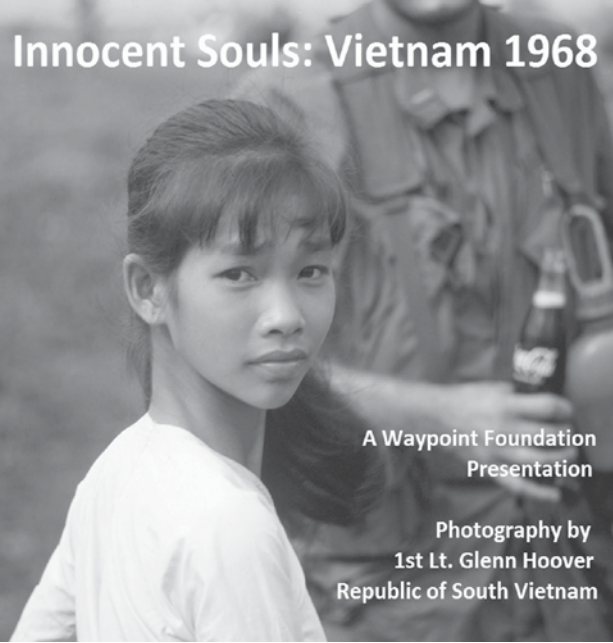

The opening reception for the photography exhibition *Innocent Souls: Vietnam 1968* and *Yesterday's Kids*, was held at the Florida Keys History and Discovery Center (FKHDC) in Islamorada on Nov. 2nd. Joining photographer Glenn Hoover was renowned Vietnamese artist Huong. Huong, a war survivor and immigrant, now lives in Miami and owns the Peace Gallery on Washington Avenue in Miami Beach. She is loaning the exhibition her famous "Red Rain" painting.

The exhibition features photographs taken during the peak of the conflict known by Americans as the Vietnam War and by Vietnamese as the American War. The images were captured by Key Largo resident Glenn Hoover while he was serving as an Infantry 1st Lieutenant in the Republic of South Vietnam. They focus on the Vietnamese and Montagnards people who lived there, as well as the young American soldiers who were visiting. The exhibition can be previewed on line at www.innocentsoulsvietnam.org.

Dr. Clarice Yentsch, President of the sponsoring Waypoint Foundation and exhibition Curator, states "We are excited about having the full exhibition in Islamorada and will be introducing a new element, *Yesterday's Kids*, to the existing canvases. *Yesterday's Kids* is a collection of contemporary portraits including several local Florida residents who actively participated in the war, or protested against it. Their poignant reflections about their personal involvement and the lessons learned are stated in each photo's caption. Images of several Montagnards refugees, who I personally interviewed, are included." The Montagnards are the indigenous people of Vietnam who fought bravely next to US Special Forces units in Vietnam's Central Highlands.

Hoover has been pleased with how

these nearly 50-year-old images have been received. "Each time we open a new exhibition, we receive many heartfelt, emotional comments and notes of appreciation. We thought that we might get this reaction from those who were there or otherwise closely affected by the War. However, we never anticipated the interest and feed back that we have received by many younger observers, including elementary school children."

Dr. Yentsch and Glenn agree that it is not the intent of the exhibition to be a documentary, nor to pass any moral judgment about the period. The photographs are a series of snap shots taken during a brief moment in time by one person. It is their hope that by looking through the eyes into the souls of the subjects, the observers will contemplate the consequences of such conflicts and perhaps ask some questions.

Glenn Hoover, now a resident of Key Largo, Florida, arrived in Vietnam in January of 1968 through a series of voluntary choices, based on beliefs of service to his country instilled in him by his father. An Army ROTC graduate of Cornell University, he received a Silver Star, Bronze Star "V" Device, Army Commendation Medal and a Combat Infantryman's Badge during his 12-month tour in Vietnam. He worked years in the hospitality industry and now owns Glenn Hoover Real Estate. He is the proud father of four children who have given him eight grandchildren.

The exhibition is dedicated to Marine Captain Jerry Zimmer, Glenn's high school classmate and football teammate. A F4 Phantom jet pilot, he was shot down while on a mission August 29th, 1969 in the mountainous Central Highlands of South Vietnam. Classified as an MIA, his wife Elaine continues an effort to locate his remains and "bring Jerry home." A

longtime writer, Elaine has chronicled her labor-of-love mission in an ongoing blog, www.bringingjerryhome.com. She welcomes all visitors to Jerry's site for an insider's look at their journey.

The Waypoint Foundation is a relatively new, private, not for profit devoted to celebrating human creativity and operating out of Key Largo. It is the primary sponsor of the exhibition. The exhibition will be available for viewing at the Florida Keys History and Discovery Center, 82100 Overseas Hwy, Islamorada, Florida 33036 from November 3rd through December 4th. The Center is open Thursdays through Sundays from 10 am to 5 pm. The Center will also be hosting a presentation by Glenn Hoover, with an opportunity for questions the evening of November 30th.

Bed Bug Infestation At The Key Largo Moose

Bed bugs are a taboo subject. No one really wants to discuss it because of the stigma attached. My skin is crawling just thinking about it!

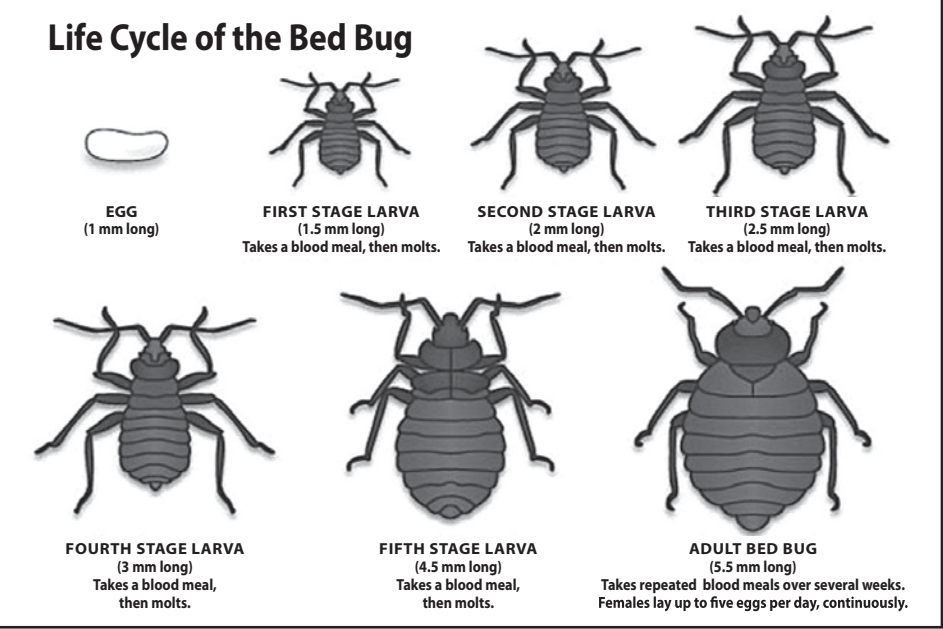
If you haven't experienced an infestation, you are fortunate.

The Key Largo Moose has a bed bug infestation upstairs in the hotel rooms and in the downstairs restaurant as well. It has been going on for months and people visiting the bar are still getting bitten each day. Tourists staying in the rooms take the critters with them on their clothes everywhere they go. You sit where they sat and bingo... you've got cooties!

Bed bugs are a devastating nightmare. A few years ago it happened to me. I was celebrating my birthday and sat in an seemingly innocent chair. The next day I had been eaten alive, bites everywhere! I brushed it off as no-see-ums, mosquitos or sand fleas. No such luck. It kept happening every night! The bites can get infected too.

I set out to cure the problem myself. I spent hundreds of dollars on every kind of spray imaginable, I switched rooms, I bought a new bed, steam cleaned the carpet, made my own spray. Fortunately for me, my problem was only in my bedroom and I gratefully paid the \$600. And after 2 visits the problem was gone forever. The bites, however,



left scars and took a long time to heal.

One of my friends bought a beautiful sofa at a local consignment shop. He took a nap and was eaten alive. The problem is that most places infested with the bugs don't do anything about them.

They don't know that victims have recourse and can file a lawsuit.

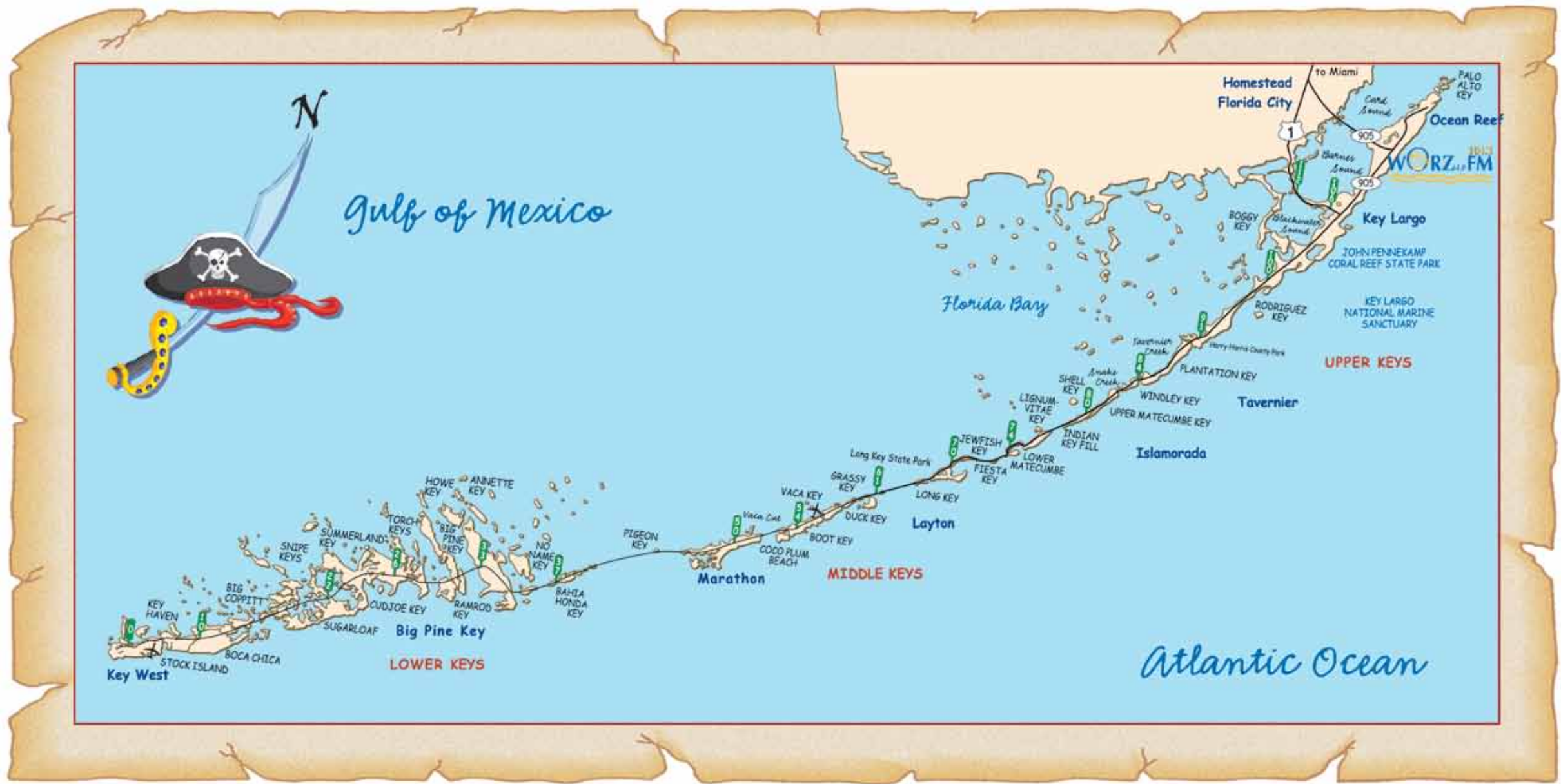

They all look to the Marine. "Private," he says.

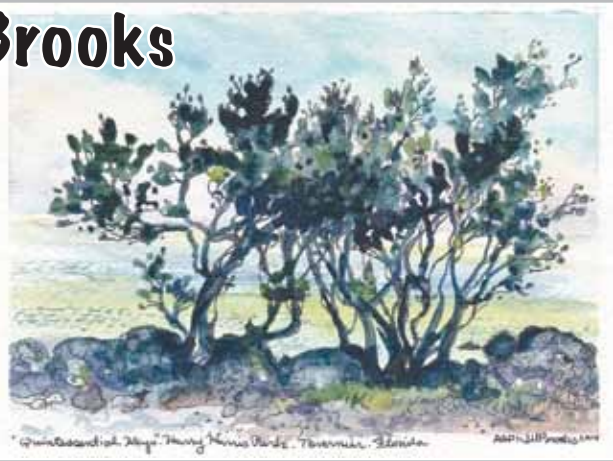

The general turns to the others and says, "Now THAT'S bravery!"

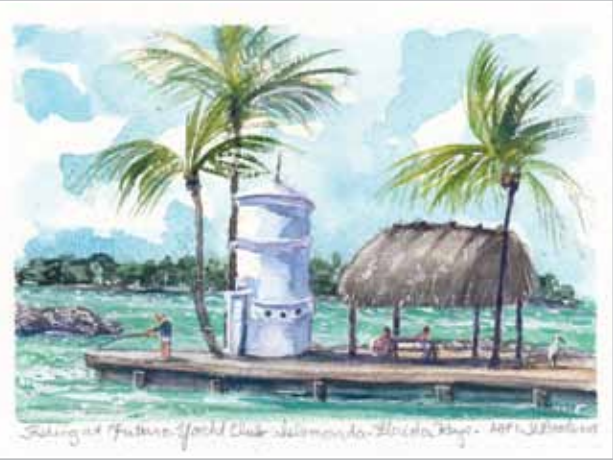

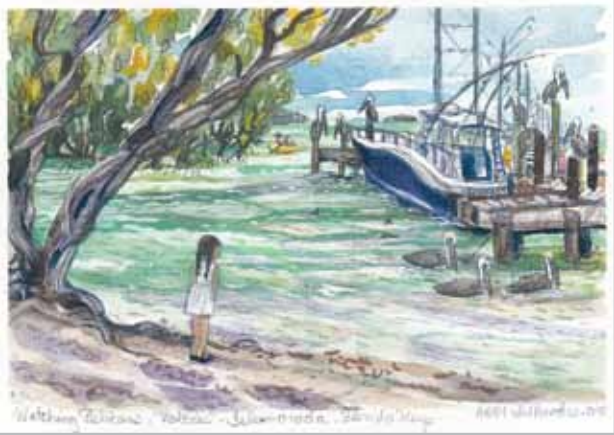

It's fall and that means apple season. Apples are a great fruit. With several varieties available, apples can be prepared in so many different ways. Not only are they delicious to snack on, but the fruit can be made into desserts and pairs well with meat such as pork. One of my favorite (and easy) ways to make a quick apple side is to slice the fruit and sautee in a pan with a dash of water, pat of butter and red hot candies. The candies add a cinnamon taste and a red color as well. I also like to bake apples (see recipe) and serve them as a dessert or a side at a brunch. Peeling the apples is a personal preference, I usually leave the peel on. Try these baked apples and I am sure that you will enjoy them.


BAKED APPLES WITH DATES

Heat the oven to 350 degrees. Using an apple of choice (Red Delicious works really well), core the apple using an apple corer or a paring knife. Rinse the apples, checking to be sure that all of the seeds have been removed.

Stuff each apple with a pitted date or raisins if you prefer. Place a pat of butter on top of each apple then brown sugar. Press down well. Sprinkle with cinnamon. Bake approximately half an hour, or more if the apples are large.


Serve the fruit warm, and for a special treat add a scoop of ice cream or a dollop of whipped cream.
