On September 2, 1935, Labor Day, the hurricane reached a peak intensity of 892 mb, making it the third most intense Atlantic hurricane on record. The hurricane made landfall later that night as a Category 5 storm, crossing the Florida Keys between Key West and Miami, FL. As it made landfall, the hurricane delivered maximum sustained winds of approximately 185 mph.

# Brew on The Bay is Coming!

Ticket sales are now open for the 6th Annual Key Largo Brew on the Bay. An expansive array of seafood dishes prepared by local chefs will for the first time be available at this year's festival which will be held at Rowell's Marina on Saturday, January 7, 2017.

The waterfront event is considered one of the best values of the Florida Keys because a \$40 ticket (\$50 at the gate) includes unlimited tasting of over 100 interesting beers. The event has grown a cult following of beer lovers of all ages who travel from across South Florida and from a number of different states.

Music by the Regs and other local bands puts everyone in the mood for fun, and the event is famous for its sunset finale on Florida Bay.

Brew on the Bay veterans say their favorite part is getting up close and personal with the people behind the craft at the annual home brew competition, to be held Friday, January 6 from 6-8 p.m. at the Key Largo Lion's Club. Admission is \$25 per person and includes appetizers from the Key Largo Conch House, music, and unlimited sampling of over 35 homebrews, the majority of which are not available to buy or taste anywhere else.
