Brew on the Bay Homebrew Showcase January 6

South Florida homebrewers take to the stage at the "Brew on the Bay Homebrew Showcase" to compete for Best in Show and People's Choice Awards on Friday, January 6 at the Lions Club in Key Largo, starting at 6pm.

The Homebrew Showcase is a local favorite event, featuring up-and-coming brewers with distinctively formulated homebrewed beer, mead, and ciders. It is the tipping point for aspiring professional brewers, having already produced two local businesses; Florida Keys Brewing Co. and Keybilly.

Homebrewers compete in four categories ranging in style from light lagers and ambers to smoked beers and anything hoppy. A panel of industry judges awards a first and second place in each category and selects a Best in Show grand prize winner. Local enthusiasts also have an opportunity to vote on their favorite brew, choosing the People's Choice for 2017.

The grand prize is a kegerator kit valued at over \$500, and opportunity to return to the Brew on the Bay event on Saturday, January 7 as a guest brewer in the VIP tent.

Craig and Cheryl McBay, owners of Florida Keys Brewing

Co., remember their beginnings. They were brewing 10 styles of craft beer by 2013 and founded the Upper Keys Homebrewers Club. The McBays also won the Brew on the Bay Homebrew People's Choice in 2013, in addition to honors in their category. The winning beer for that year was their Flakey Key Lime Witbier.

"Craig became very passionate about brewing, and he was good at it," Cheryl describes in an interview. The tipping point came a few years later when they turned their passion into a business that the community now enjoys.

"It's fun! We do what we love, and that is being successful in life," she says. Florida Keys Brewing Co. has brewed over 60 different styles of beers and offer 10 styles on tap daily at the brewery in Islamorada. They support the growth of the craft beer industry and are this year's Homebrew Showcase sponsor.

The Brew on the Bay Homebrew Showcase is open to quests over 21. Get tickets at keylargobrewonthebay.com, \$25 in advance and \$30 at the door. Admission includes unlimited samplings from homebrew entrants and appetizers provided by the Conch House.





The month of January usually brings us some brisk weather. But, sadly, as we all know, this Winter has been warm. I like to make soup this time of the year, so I will continue the tradition. This is a great onion soup recipe created by my husband. It is really delicious. Be sure to prepare it a day ahead. Enjoy!

KEYS PARASAIL & WAVE RUNNERS

PAUL'S FRENCH ONION SOUP

3 to 5 finely chopped garlic cloves I large diced onion 48 oz of beef broth 3 cans consume 1/4 stick of butter 5 large sliced onions (3 yellow - 2 sweet) 2 tablespoons catsup 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce sprinkle of salt sprinkle of cayenne pepper fresh ground black pepper 1/2 cup of sherry (optional)

Melt the butter in a stockpot. Sautee the garlic and diced onion until translucent. Add the remaining ingredients. Bring to a boil then simmer until the onions are tender. Serve with the French bread and cheese recipe below.

Cut French bread into 1/2 inch slices. Heat extra virgin olive oil in a sauce pan. Add garlic powder. Brown the bread on both sides. Spoon the soup in an oven proof bowl or crock. Place one slice of the browned French bread on top. Add slices of mozzarella, cheese, grated parmesan cheese, and a dash of paprika. Place under the broiler until the cheese melts.

Artist of the Month: Alberto Rodriguez-Stephenson




