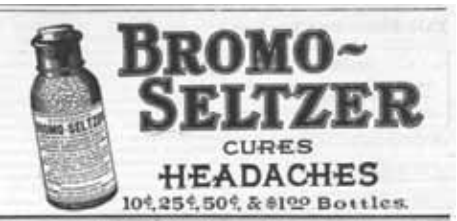

New Game Sweeps Key Largo

"I'm naked!" screeched the quiet little gray haired former school teacher. Sitting two stools down from her at the bar, a young man yells "I'm waiting!"

After a few more cards are drawn, someone finally hollers out "Show me the money!" and then all hell breaks loose! The dealer checks the winning hand and deems it a good Show Me The Money hand, and the winner pockets a wad of dough, dead presidents, and lots of them.

No one seems to know where the game originated but for only \$10 or less you can join the party and have a great time.

How it is played:

Several decks of playing cards are involved. Assorted cards are randomly stapled together in a pack of 3 cards and each pack cost \$1. Play as many as you want. The dealer has several decks of cards shuffled and calls out cards one at a time giving players enough time to mark their cards (beer can pull tabs are provided for marking the cards). Soon the bantering among players and the dealer begin. "When are you going to call a club? I've got my thong on (meaning the player had one marked card and is no longer naked. Naked is when you have no cards marked. When the player marks all 3 of the cards in his or her pack they yell out "Show Me The Money!" Pots are determined by how many players there are and the amount is announced before the beginning of each game. The dealer keeps a portion of each pot aside for the 10th, and usually last, game of the night and that can get as high as \$300.
