Max doesn't question her purpose or try to be her family and friends. She is weary of strangers and establishes trust over time. Max is sure that she is worthy of love and belonging. Very sure.

For us emotionally wrought humans, we could practice being like Max or (insert your pet here). If you wish you had more love, attention or self-worth; ask for what you want.

We have been experiencing this year's spring. Though we have had some wind, it still is a nice time of year... before the heat of summer approaches. This is also the month that we celebrate Mother's Day. which is May 14th. Many moms are celebrated by a special brunch or dinner topped off with a tasty dessert. The pie recipe below is slightly different in that it combines chocolate with the taste of orange and is quite yummy. So prepare it for a special event or any night of the week Enjoy!

#### CHOCOLATE FUDGE AND ORANGE PIE

4 ounces unsweetened chocolate, cut into pieces

10 tablespoons unsalted butter

2 large eggs, plus

2 large egg yolks  $1\frac{3}{4}$  cup sugar

 $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

½ cup orange juice (or you may use Grand Marnier)

2 tablespoons orange marmalade

One 9-inch frozen pie crust

Powdered sugar and whipped cream for serving

Defrost and prebake the pie crust according to the instructions on the package. Place aside. Meanwhile, melt the chocolate and butter in a sauce pan on low heat. Set aside. In a bowl, combine the eggs, yolks, sugar, salt, vanilla extract, and flour. Whisk to combine. Whisk in the orange juice, marmalade, and the chocolate

Pour into the pie crust and bake in a preheated 375° oven for 45 minutes. If the edges of the pie appear to darken too quickly, just cover with strips of foil. Cool completely.

Sprinkle on the powdered sugar and serve with a dollop of whipped
