He then asked her if she wouldn't mind telling him a little about her first three husbands and what they did for a living.




Due to the recent actions of a specific condo owner, we have been forced to update our community rules. Please find new rules below:

This recipe allows you a different method of preparing shrimp, and it is grilled, so it takes you out of the kitchen. The flavors mesh together very well and you can serve the shrimp with grilled vegetables on the side. Try it — I think that you will enjoy this variation of shrimp.

## MARINATED AND GRILLED SHRIMP

- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup honey
- $\frac{1}{4}$  cup Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- Pinch of dried sage
- 3 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- Fresh cracked pepper
- 24 large shrimp, peeled and cleaned

Mix together the first 7 ingredients. Add the cleaned shrimp, cover, and marinate in the fridge for about 3 hours. Place on skewers. If the skewers are wooden, soak them in water first to prevent burning.
