

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

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
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Fred Feldman

Husband, father, sailor, New York City firefighter, tireless community advocate, and a long-time president of the Friends of the Key Largo Library, Fred Feldman died on Saturday, May 11th at age 93, at the home of his daughter, Nina Smiley.

In 1977, Fred retired to Key Largo to sail with his beloved wife Frieda. His love of books led him to facilitate the development of the Key Largo Library, from three small rooms of donated paperbacks to a large and world-class community institution.

A founding member of the Latitude 25 Writer's Group Fred was a prolific writer of short stories and author of "Tales from Engine 281."

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Sonora Louise Smart Dodd first brought up the idea of a father's day in 1909. She wanted a special day to honor her father, William Smart.

When Sonora's mother died in childbirth with her sixth child, William was left to raise the newborn and five other children by himself on a farm in Washington state. As an adult, Sonora realized how strong and unselfish her dad had been raising his kids as a single parent.

Sonora wanted Father's

Day to be celebrated on the first Sunday in June, because it was close to her dad's birthday. Instead, the first Father's Day celebration took place on June 19, 1910 in Spokane, Washington.

In 1966, President Lyndon Johnson made the third Sunday of June Father's Day.

It wasn't until 1972 that President Richard Nixon made Father's Day a national holiday - about 60 years after Mother's Day had been made a national holiday.

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

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Ocean Reef Grants \$48,000 For Upper Keys Youth Coaches

The Ocean Reef Community Foundation has granted the Florida Keys Children's Shelter \$48,000 to help fund a Recreation Coach. Life Skills Coach, and Education Coach, all three employed full-time at the 19-bed Youth Center in Plantation Key.

"Our strategic plan created by our Executive Council and productivity expert Elisa Levy in 2017 called for employing staff with bachelor's degrees and specific expertise to provide a more quality experience for the youth ages 11-17 who live here," said Florida Keys Children's Shelter CEO Ben Kemmer. "Whether a young person stays with us for just a few nights or for months, the coaches make a difference."


Ocean Reef dollars that are helping fund the gap between government grants and the salaries needed to attract and retain skilled professionals," Kemmer said. "Our cost of living is higher than other areas receiving the same funding as we do. And here in


the Keys we're competing with tourism. You can make more money working in a restaurant or retail store than the wage that the state budgets for us to pay youth support staff," he said.

The Ocean Reef Community Foundation also granted

nearly \$4,000 for Florida Keys Children's Shelter residents to participate in educational field trips this summer, organized by Reef Environmental Education Foundation.

The grant to the Children's Shelter was among the largest of the more than \$1.3 million distributed by Ocean Reef Community Foundation to dozens of nonprofit organizations. Other programs in the Upper Keys receiving the largest grants this year included the Guidance/Care Center, Habitat for Humanity of the Upper Keys, Take Stock in Children, Key Largo YMCA, Key Largo School, and Florida Keys Community College. 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






















The Mangrove Galley by Sandi Mieszczenski



This easy and tasty recipe was given to my husband while standing knee-deep in the Indian River Lagoon at Sabastian Inlet back when it was still safe to eat clams dug up from that area. Unfortunately, that was a long time ago, but we still enjoy this dish as a great appetizer and have for years.

SIMPLE CLAMS CASINO

This recipe is based on a dozen clams, which is never enough. Adjust the ingredients according to the number of clams.

A dozen middleneck clams Half cup finely diced green pepper (or red) Half cup finely diced onion 1 Tbls. finely minced garlic Tabasco or hot sauce of your preference Bacon cut into 1" squares

Place the clams on a cookie sheet or other suitable pan. Bake in a 350 degree oven or grill until they open, about 5 to 7 minutes. Remove from the heat and let stand until they are cool enough to handle to pry off the top shell. Remove the meat from the shell and rinse to remove any grit. Place each clam back on its shell and return to the sheet or pan. To assemble, sprinkle each clam with the pepper, onion and garlic divided equally, followed by two or three drops of the hot sauce with the bacon square on top.

If cooking in the oven, set the rack to the second position from the top, turn the broiler to low and place the clams on the rack. Cook until the bacon is crisp. On the grill, place the pan over medium heat with the grill cover closed and again, cook until the bacon is crisp. Enjoy!







You cringe for a bit and before long you move on with your life. You don't go back to the offending item and demand an apology or sulk over its lack of empathy or compassion. In fact, you're more likely to take charge by applying some first aid to the injury. Because after all, you wouldn't want this injury to hinder you from living your life!

Now replace the coffee table/LEGO/dog toy with an emotional or psychological injury caused by your ex, friend, spouse, parent or child. Instead of focusing on first aid, you spend weeks, months or even years obsessing over the need for a heartfelt apology and acknowledgment they understand how they've hurt you.

I get it. The inanimate object is not able to soothe

you so it's easier to let go. But in my worldview, if the person who hurt you was able to make authentic amends, they would have. In all my years of working with clients, no one has ever withheld an apology for a rational reason. So you have a few choices to make...

Keep placing your healing in the hands of someone else. Or, get busy nursing your wound to health. Or even better enlist a team of people to help nurse you to health.
