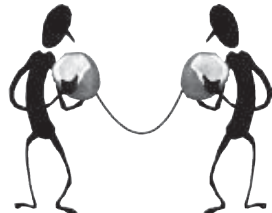

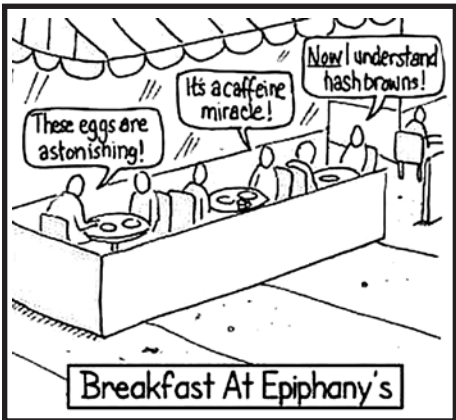
Editorial: Cruise to Nowhere
