





Florida Keys Farm - The Simpson Family Farm in Key Largo

From where the old Red Cross building has sat vacant for years, and all the way back to the Florida Bay, sits 6 acres of land belonging to the Simpson family and their investing partners that is the Florida Keys Farm. They hold the only wholesale farmers market license in the Keys! Just a few steps off the main highway, you take a step back in time to old Florida, before all the prime properties such as this were leveled to make way for the hundreds of sprawling hotels that now inhabit this once peaceful chain of islands.

Farming in the Keys is perhaps the second oldest profession and it dates back to the 1800s in Monroe County. The wreckers farmed the land when they couldn't be at sea.

I was enthralled when

OJ Simpson (not the infamous one) gave me a half-dozen, farm-fresh, free-range, organic eggs from his farm in Key Largo to try. Farm fresh eggs are healthier than store bought as they have less cholesterol. The eggs were delicious and I was able to visit the farm at MM 94 and meet the family.

OJ's son Jonathan, who runs the farm, is also a general contractor who builds pump stations throughout Florida's agricultural lands. He holds two Masters degrees, in Finance and Real Estate. Jonathan introduced me to his mother, Vicki... several pregnant Nubian goats, and a slew of friendly chickens! One of the goats was ready to deliver at any moment. When she stood up and shook her backside

we thought "Here it comes!" but it was a false alarm -

just another biological func-

The family plans to use goat milk to make soap and other products. Jonathan pointed out dozens and dozens of pineapple plants, and 60 bee hives, and then rattled off a list of all the organic citrus they plan to grow in the rich soil they compost. They have great plans for the future, including turning the old Red Cross building into a Farmers Market where other locals can bring their organic fruit and vegetables to sell. They also plan to grow hemp

According to the Florida Department of Agriculture, Hemp can replace plastic and has over 25,000 uses! They will also give tours of the farm to local school children. What an asset this is to the community!

However, although they don't have any cows it seems Monroe County has a "beef" with them and is causing such a stink that the Simpsons have had to file a lawsuit to stop the harassment. Florida farms are regulated by the State of Florida, who is behind the family 100%.

In the lower Keys the Townsend Farms have two locations, the primary farm is located at 1605 N. Roosevelt Blvd in Key West and the other at 3180 US 1 at Baby's Coffee. A private farmer in Islamorada has a commercial citrus grove across the street from Founders Park, and in Big Pine Key there is an old tropical fruit Grove called Grimal Grove. Why shouldn't we have one here?









You can catch Bob doing his Karaoke show at the Elks Lodge in Tavernier one Friday every month. "There is nothing more exhilarating than the feeling I get from the crowds, when the energy I give performing comes back." Bob has a magic ability to make people move and groove, and he loves it.

Bob's older brother John was his biggest motivation to sing growing up.

John was a self-taught musical prodigy, he had an amazing voice and could play any instrument he picked up. Not to be overshadowed by his big brother, Bob started singing at age 12 with the church men's groups. He was mentored by two friends, Ruben and Randy, when they realized his talented abilities and ease of range from baritone to falsetto.

When I first met Bob in 1996, we were both karaoke hosts at Woody's in the pre-strip club days. We were competing in a contest for Aretha Franklin concert tickets and a limo ride to the show. Bob showed up dressed as Aretha and sang 'Never Loved a Man' and brought the house down. Needless to say, I didn't win that contest! That left a lasting impression and started our 20+ year friendship.

Bob moved to the Keys from Philadelphia in 1992, shortly after Hurricane Andrew had blown through. As he was driving through the devastation, he remembers thinking, "What did I get myself into?" But it all worked out well. He first worked as Head Baker at Ocean Reef, then for the

bakery at Publix in Key Largo and Key West.

His dream of owning a restaurant came true soon after that, when he took over the Islamorada Restaurant and Bakery, which is now called Bob's Bunz.

With his culinary degrees and apprenticeships from Longwood Gardens and Hotel on Top of Bellevue in Philadelphia, he was on his way to creating artistic delights that satisfy every palate.

Bob's Bunz Restaurant and Bakery is open 7 days a week from 6am - 2pm for breakfast and lunch, serving home-style comfort food that combines the Keys with Philly flare. In the bakery, he decorates amazing wedding cakes and makes mouth-watering home-made pastries. His most famous creations are his cinnamon and sticky buns.

With her intense color and robust story behind every creation, it's not surprising she has won coveted awards from the Florida, Miami, and Gold Coast Watercolor Societies. Her spirit shines in her expression of people, nature scenes and real-life images of Keys scenes and pictures taken while traveling. I thought one must be a photograph, it was a watercolor of Park Ranger Shep. He's climbing to retrieve a flag torn from the 'Spirit of Pennecamp' glass bottom boat, that had blown into a tree with salt-sprayed, broken, branches, barren of leaves after Hurricane Irma. It grabbed me, I stopped, and admired the bravery portrayed. Resilience in a time where the Keys might have taken a tough blow, but the determination to rebuild shined through. #Keysstrong

With her new-found passion for painting Rita discovered in 2007, she used the expression of watercolors to stay strong and beat the obstacles in life. Through her hard work and dedication, she was named the President of the Florida Watercolor Society in 2017. Currently, she is Communications Director for FWS and helps
