

The Mangrove Galley by Sandi Mieszczenski



It is that time of year, that on occasion, the temperature gets down enough to call it soup weather. I know that broccoli is one of those vegetables that people either

love or hate, but this soup is tasty, quick and easy.

BROCCOLI - CHEESE SOUP

3 stalks of broccoli coarsely chopped; florets only

4 oz. sharp Cheddar cheese cut into small cubes

2 10-1/2 oz. cans of chicken broth

1 large onion medium chopped

4 Tbls of butter divided in 2

3 Tbls flour

1 small carrot medium chopped

1 tsp garlic powder

1 cup heavy whipping cream

Fresh ground pepper to taste

In a large sauce pan, melt one half of the butter and sauté the chopped onion until the edges just start to brown. Remove from heat and scrape the onions into a small bowl. Return the pan to a medium heat stovetop and melt the second pad of butter. Add the flour to the butter and whisk until a roux is formed. Whisk for two to three minutes until the flour taste has cooked out. Add the onions back into the pan. Be sure to scrape all of the butter out of the bowl and mix well with the roux. Add the two cans of broth and the broccoli to the pan.

Stir well and bring to a simmer. Cover and cook until the broccoli is just tender; 10 to 15 minutes. Add the garlic and cheese cubes, stir well and turn off the heat. Leave the covered pan on the burner stirring occasionally until just before you are ready to serve. Add the cup of whipping cream, stir, and gently bring back to just short of a boil. Serve with some croutons or cracker crumbles. Serves four. Enjoy!

The car started moving slowly. John looked at the road ahead and saw a curve approaching. Scared, he started to pray, begging for his life. Then, just before the car hit


the curve, a hand appeared out of nowhere through the window, and turned the wheel. John, paralysed with terror, watched as the hand came through the window, but never touched or harmed him.
