


5. Make Plenty of Pit Stops





Carrots, Eggs, or Coffee... Which are you?







A young woman went to her grandmother and told her about her life and how things were so hard for her. She did not know how she was going to make it and wanted to give up. It seemed as one problem was solved a new one arose.







In truth, many wonderful


