



## Florida Keys Dar Adopts Grace Lutheran School Classroom

The Florida Keys chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution is steadily making its way geographically among the keys as it adopts classrooms by bestowing a teacher with all her wants and needs. The Keys' DAR, a women's service organization dedicated to promoting historic preservation and education, began participating in the DAR's Community Classroom effort in 2021. As she thanked the DAR, Ferrell said her largest class is comprised of 22 kids. DAR member Kyla Piscopink of Key West, whose son attends Grace Lutheran School, encouraged her to apply.
