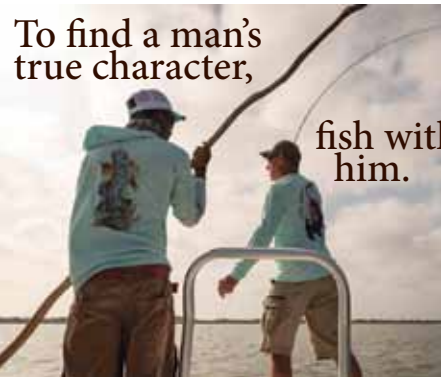


Coco'Nut' Funnies

Barbie never gave me a poor body image. Barbie taught me that you can't reattach a head once it's been removed from the body.



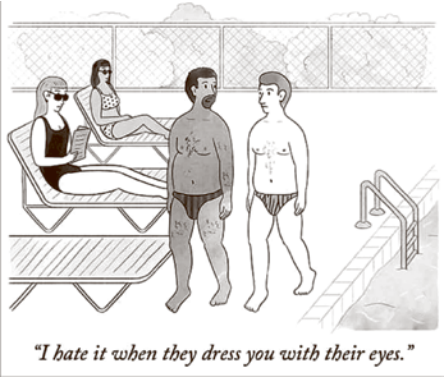
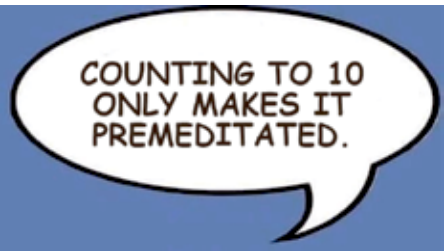
Florida Woman Stops Alligator Attack Using a .22 caliber Pistol

Flight attendant: Is there a doctor onboard?

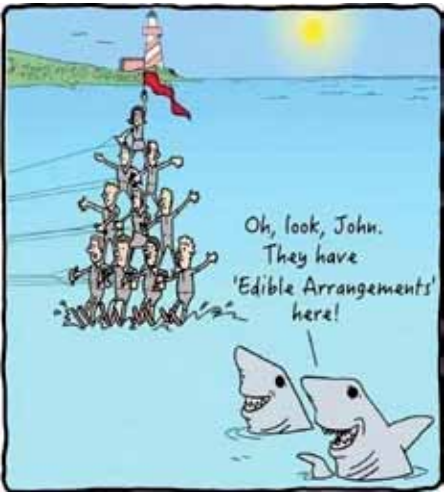
Dad: *nudging me* that should've been you.

“Ever since that night we never had any problems.”

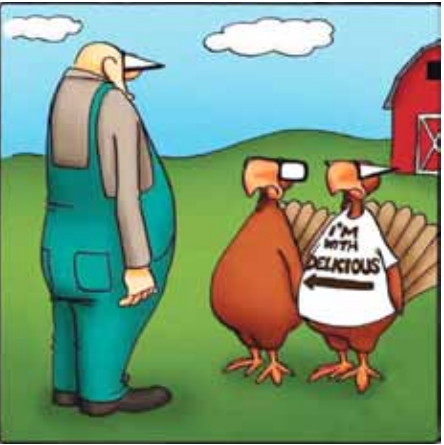
“Hmmm,” said Mike. He thought that might be a good thing to try. On his honeymoon, Mike took off his pants and said to Karen, “Here - try these on.”

He did and said, “I can’t get into your pants.” Karen said, “Exactly. And if you don’t change your smart ass attitude, you never will.”



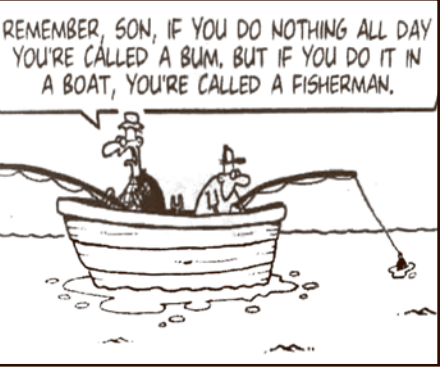
I try to be a good person, then someone pulls out in front of me doing 10 below the speed limit, and I have to try again tomorrow.

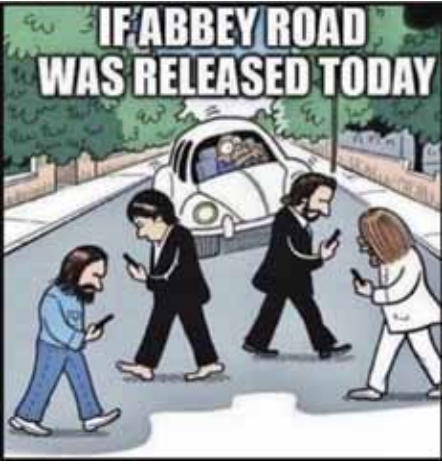

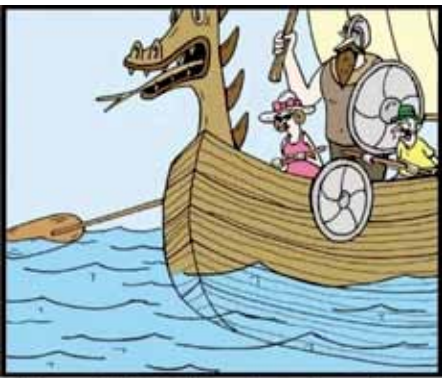
Last year I replaced all the windows in my house with those expensive, double-pane, energy-efficient kind.
