

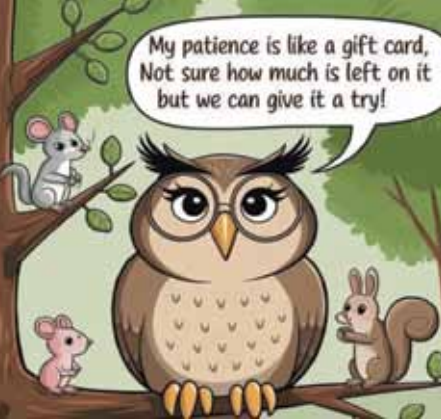
Coco'Nut' Funnies

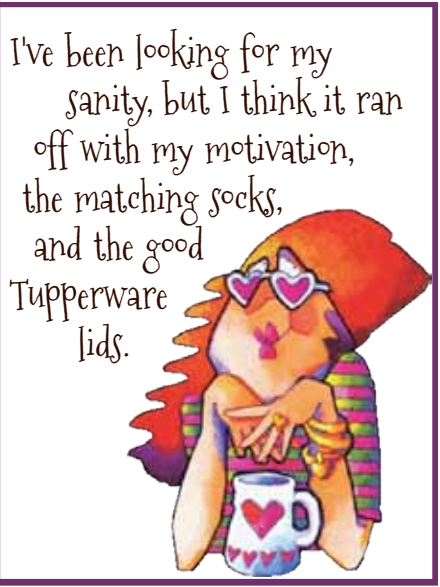

I recently joined a support group for people who talk a lot. We call ourselves On and On Anon.

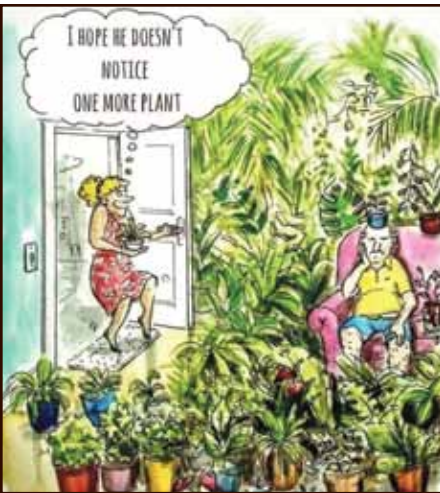
